Hwange is the largest protected area in Zimbabwe, with an abundance of wildlife.

52 300 HECTARES

Wilderness Safaris' private Makalolo and Linkwasha concessions make up **3.6%** of the total Park.

Over the **past 8 years**, statistics from the annual Hwange Game Count indicate that significant numbers of the Park's wildlife are found in our concessions during the dry season.
