AIRLINES

Due to maintenance on one of its jet carriers, **Proflight** has had to cancel some of its Johannesburg – Lusaka flights, as well as ad-hoc Durban – Lusaka flights for the period 10 June 2023 to 15 August 2023.

Safari Air Link has launched an updated route connecting Tanzania's northern and southern safari circuits with direct flights between Serengeti and Ruaha, Nyerere, and Mikumi national parks from 01 June 2023. Until now this connection has been challenging due to the requirement of a minimum of 4 passengers per route. The airline will now be operating this route three times a week on Wednesdays, Fridays, and Sundays with a minimum of just 2 passengers, on the basis that onward or prior flights to/from Dar es Salaam, Zanzibar, Mafia and Nyerere NP are also booked with Safari Air Link at the same time. The luggage allowance (including hand luggage) is 23kg as standard on all flights. All flights are timed to connect with third-party flights to/from Kilimanjaro and Arusha airports.

Airlink has increased the frequency of its flights from Johannesburg to Vilancoulos to 11 flights a week, starting from 08 January 2024. MQP (Kruger Mpumalanga Airport) – VNX (Vilancoulos) will be discontinued as of 05 January 2024. The passengers already booked on this route will be transferred via Johannesburg. Clients will now need to connect via an indirect route traveling via Johannesburg.

BOTSWANA

SOUTH AFRICA

- Babylonstoren has increased its rates for both 2023 and 2024 due to the introduction of new activities, which are included in the accommodation rates. As such, a minimum of 3 nights is recommended to ensure guests will be able to partake in all the activities and experiences that are on offer.
- Sabi Sabi Earth Lodge Amber Suite has officially re-opened after having undergone a full refurb. TANZANIA

The **Zanzibar Government** has announced an immediate increase to the Zanzibar Infrastructure Tax, from USD1 per person per night up to USD2, USD4 or USD5 per person per night, depending on hotel grading, as of 01 July 2023. This tax is not included in any upfront charges to guests/agents as it is payable directly to the property on check-out. The new tax amounts will affect all guests staying at any Zanzibar hotels.

Coastal Aviation has resumed daily flights to Pemba as of 01 July 2023, as well as daily flights to Mafia and Songosongo. The airline has also acquired a brand-new, state of the art aircraft – a C208EX Cessna Caravan. The aircraft has enhanced safety features such as Garmin Electronic Protection and Stability (EPS) and the Advanced Terrain Awareness Warning System (TAWS).

Gibbs Farm has launched its "Just for Kids" activities tailored to keep children entertained. From kids' yoga, art classes, cooking classes, a play tent and story time, to nocturnal animal walks, there is so much to choose from. The property has also introduced a NOHRD gym, as well as a wide range of activities for a pre- or post-safari workout, including swimming in the lap pool, guided bike tours, guided running, yoga classes, meditation with Yoga Alliance teachers, and a variety of guided walks. There is also a new three-day Wellness Package on offer. The property has also installed Wi-Fi boosters throughout so that guests have better connectivity all over the property, as well as conducted a soft refurbishment of the rooms.
