## **AIRLINES**

<u>Coastal Air</u> acquired a new Caravan C208 for their fleet on 03 October 2023. As of 01 November 2023 morning flights to Mafia Island will be offered again, and also as of 01 November 2023 the airline is resuming flights to Tanga from Dar es Salaam via Zanzibar.

#### **BOTSWANA**

<u>Chobe Safari Lodge</u> will be undergoing renovations for the period 8 January through September 2024. During this period the hotel will remain open, and every effort will be made to ensure minimal disruption to guests.

#### **MOZAMBIQUE**

Anantara Bazaruto guests now have to fly Nelspruit – Johannesburg – Vilankulo, with a scheduled arrival time of 3.45 pm, after the cancellation of the Airlink Nelspruit – Vilankulo flight, effective from January 2024. This means that guests arriving on this flight will be required to book a helicopter transfer or a private boat transfer, as the shared boat transfer departs for the resort at 3.30 pm. Guests using the same return flight to Johannesburg will be able to get a late checkout at 2.30 pm and use a helicopter transfer.

<u>&Beyond Benguerra Island</u> will undergo a refresh during the period 08 January to 15 July 2024. Benguerra Island will remain open at this time, with specific sections temporarily closed to facilitate the lodge enhancements. As part of this exciting upgrade, rooms will be rethatched and new windows installed. Moreover, all room interiors will be refreshed, with the inclusion of expanded air conditioning capacity, for enhanced comfort and luxury.

### **NAMIBIA**

<u>Catamaran Charters</u> is pleased to note it has broadened its product palette and expanded its service range by introducing its own seal kayaking adventure operation at Pelican Point.

The operations are run with the utmost care to ensure the least disturbance to the environment, while offering a great and interactive encounter with seals from the nearby colonies.

Transport from the Walvis Bay Waterfront to the kayaking site at Pelican Point is by 10-seater stretch Land Cruiser. For larger groups the transfer is by boat from the Waterfront. The tour includes a light breakfast with coffee and tea, as well as fresh Namibian oysters with sparkling wine. The tour can also be combined with an afternoon tour to Sandwich Harbour.



<u>Onguma Tented Camp</u> is thrilled to announce plans for an upgrade and will be closing Tented Camp for 2 months, from 01 January through 29 February 2024. Maintaining its intimate tented camp style, it will reopen on 1 March 2024.

Ongava Game Reserve has announced new camp closures and rate changes. Both Ongava Tented Camp and Little Ongava will be closed from Thursday 11 January 2024 to Sunday 31 March 2024, inclusive. ## Accommodation and rate basis changes

- Each Little Ongava reservation includes a sole-use guide and vehicle.

- Ongava 2024 rates include a non-commissionable Conservation Levy inclusive of VAT per person per day.

Please note the following changes for the Wolwedans camps:

## Desert Lodge

- Currently closed, and reopening on 1 June 2024 with the same booking terms as Dune Camp
- From 1 June the per-person RACK rate will be R 8 500 (just over 30% lower than the Dune Camp rate)
- Arrivals will be on any day of the week for both FITs and groups
- The minimum stay remains 2 nights
- The old swimming pool will become a vegetable garden, providing organic ingredients for the kitchen
- A new swimming pool will be built at the front of the lodge to take in the view and allow for swimming and sun-lounging
- The main area, rooms and bathrooms are also being refreshed

# **Dune Camp**

- Due to the high demand, Dune Camp will be closing from 1 June to 15 July 2024 for a kitchen refurbishment
- There are only 2 affected bookings, which will be upgraded by Wolwedans and the consultants in charge of these reservations will be informed accordingly

- Increase from ZAR115 to ZAR125 in South Africa
- Increase from USD10 to USD12 at Stanley & Livingstone, and from USD5 to USD6 at Ursula's Homestead

## **TANZANIA**

<u>Serengeti Balloon Safaris</u> is launching a new flight route in Tarangire National Park in December 2023. Flights will be available year-round except during April and May.

The launch site is in the north-western corner of the Silale Swamp where the flight takes off in time to catch the sunrise over the Tarangire River system. Using the power of the thermals and prevailing winds, the flight offers views of Lolkisale Hill as it stretches down over the vast open Silale Swamp. From there, the route heads south into the picturesque Tarangire River valley, fringed with towering baobab trees, before landing for a sumptuous breakfast in the shade of a baobab.

With its diverse wildlife and exceptional bird life, Tarangire offers a great alternative flight location to the Serengeti.
