GENERAL UPDATES

Asilia Africa's Rekeru Camp in the Masai Mara National Reserve is closing earlier than usual this year to embark on a refurbishment to redesign the tents and main areas. The main areas are being upgraded and will almost double in size, with a new wraparound deck to maximise views of the river. A library is being added, which will double as a private dining area, creating a cosy space where Rekeru's history will be told through a collection of photographs. The standard tents' overall layout will remain the same, but will be redecorated. The bathrooms are being upgraded to offer additional privacy through dividers and wooden screens. The two-family tents are being completely replaced with a new design that offers more comfort for families and is now also suited to those travelling with older children. The main en suite bedroom will be very similar to the standard tents, joined to the second room by a communal living area. The second room has two single beds that can be made into a double, or even a triple if needed, and, crucially, will also have its own bathroom. The orientation of the family tents will remain as before, with only the main bedroom facing onto the river. It is, therefore, suitable for adults travelling together as well as adults with children, but it is important to note that the bedrooms are not identical. Rekeru will re-open in June for the new season and remain a "Classic" camp tier. The aim is to retain its well-loved character and history, maximise its unique position, and make it a tranquil and comfortable haven for guests.

Asilia Africa has advised that the Narok County Government has implemented a new Narok County Bed Levy, which will be applicable when staying at Rekeru Camp. The new fees will be applied to new and existing bookings at Rekeru Camp from the 1st of June 2024. And, at Naboisho Camp, fly camping now requires a minimum 3-night stay.
