AIRLINES

Auric Air will introduce a new flight schedule from the 1st of June on the current Dar – Iringa – Ruaha route, to address the inconvenience faced by passengers. There will be a tourist flight from Dar Es Salaam to Nyerere National Park and Ruaha National Park that will no longer stop in Iringa. Dar – Iringa – Dar will be a separate flight to enhance the travel experience.

TANZANIA

Burunge North Tented Lodge, the newest addition to the Tanganyika Wilderness Camps portfolio, opens its doors on the 1st of June 2024. On the shores of Lake Burunge, it is conveniently located just a short distance from the existing Burunge Tented Lodge. The 25 rooms are elevated on platforms and offer breath-taking views of Lake Burunge and Tarangire National Park. The lodge will also feature a well-appointed mess area with lounges, a restaurant, and a refreshing swimming pool.

Kula's, the main restaurant at Four Seasons Safari Lodge Serengeti, will be closed until the 1st of May 2024, while a complete revitalisation project is underway. The goal for the extensive enhancement is to deliver a brighter and more elevated dining experience. No inconvenience to guests is anticipated over this period and dining will continue to be available at Maji Bar and Terrace, Boma Grill, in the villas, and various other sites in and around the lodge.

Usangu Expedition Camp in Ruaha National Park (part of Asilia Africa) is now only open for the season from the 1st of June to the 30th of November 2024, and not until the 31st of January 2025 as planned. The camp has also introduced a new minimum 3-night stay for bookings going forward. At Jabali Ridge and Jabali Private House, fishing has been added as a charged activity.

One Nature Nyaruswiga has added a new Astral Observatory to its offering, featuring a cutting-edge telescope, to offer guests an amazing stargazing and astronomical adventure.
