AIRLINES

Singapore Airlines will increase the frequency of flights between Johannesburg and Singapore in December. The airline will add a three-times weekly service to its already daily schedule, bringing the total frequency up to 10 flights a week for the period 11 December – 10 January 2025, and from 02 April 2025 – 24 October 2025. The flights will be operated by an Airbus A350-900.

South African low-cost airline, **FlySafair**, has announced another regional route to its line-up – Cape Town to Windhoek. It's the airline's first regional route out of the Mother City, and the twice-weekly flights commence on 22 October 2024. They will run on Tuesdays and Saturdays.

Federal Airlines is excited to announce the addition of its first Pilatus PC-12NG to their fleet, enhancing their private charter network. This eight-seater aircraft offers fast, pressurised service for small groups, high-end leisure clients, corporate travellers, and individuals visiting South Africa's luxury safari lodges and other destinations. The PC-12NG's versatility and performance make it ideal for both domestic and regional travel across Africa, featuring a modern interior and onboard lavatory for added comfort.

Federal Air – Fastjet's leisure product flies between Vic Falls (VFA) and Johannesburg (JNB), twice and sometimes tree times per day.

KENYA

Asilia Africa's OI Pejeta Camp has made a change to their service offering with immediate effect – the electric vehicle that was based at the camp and formed part of the safari vehicle fleet, is unfortunately no longer available. After assessing impact and viability, it was concluded that the OI Pejeta electric safari vehicle is no longer meeting the expected sustainability goals. Asilia remains committed to the use of electric vehicles, but further research and testing is required, and the company plans to introduce electric vehicles in the future for their city transfers. SOUTH AFRICA

TANZANIA

The Government of Zanzibar is introducing a new Zanzibar Mandatory Inbound Travel Insurance which will apply to all visitors (excludes residents) entering Zanzibar from 01 October 2024. All foreign visitors will be required to purchase this travel insurance at a cost of USD44 per person, prior to arriving in Zanzibar. The insurance can only be obtained through Zanzibar Insurance Corporation (ZIC) and a QR code. All travellers will be required to purchase this insurance regardless of whether they have obtained travel insurance elsewhere. The basic cover provided is the cost of emergency medical expenses and repatriation expenses (body and medical), personal accident, baggage delay, theft and lost, legal expenses, and personal liability for a maximum of 92 consecutive days.

Gibbs Farm has partnered with Thalia Beauty and set up a new salon in the old stables venue next to the new art gallery. Thalia's Salon offers guests hair treatments, and manicure and pedicure nail treatments. The Artist in Residence programme has been operating at Gibb's Farm for over 20 years to support Tanzanian artists. The artists who participate in the programme stay at Gibb's Farm for 6–8 weeks and work and exhibit their paintings and carvings for sale to guests. The artists rotate regularly to provide more exposure and opportunities to the art community. Paint-and-sip classes are offered with easels with paint and canvas set up around the grounds, and



while the artist provides guidance, staff serve wine with a selection of farm-made cheeses. There are also painting classes for younger guests, served with hot chocolate and marshmallows.

MOZAMBIQUE

White Pearl Resorts has initiated a significant renovation project aimed at restoring the resort to its renowned glory and international acclaim.
