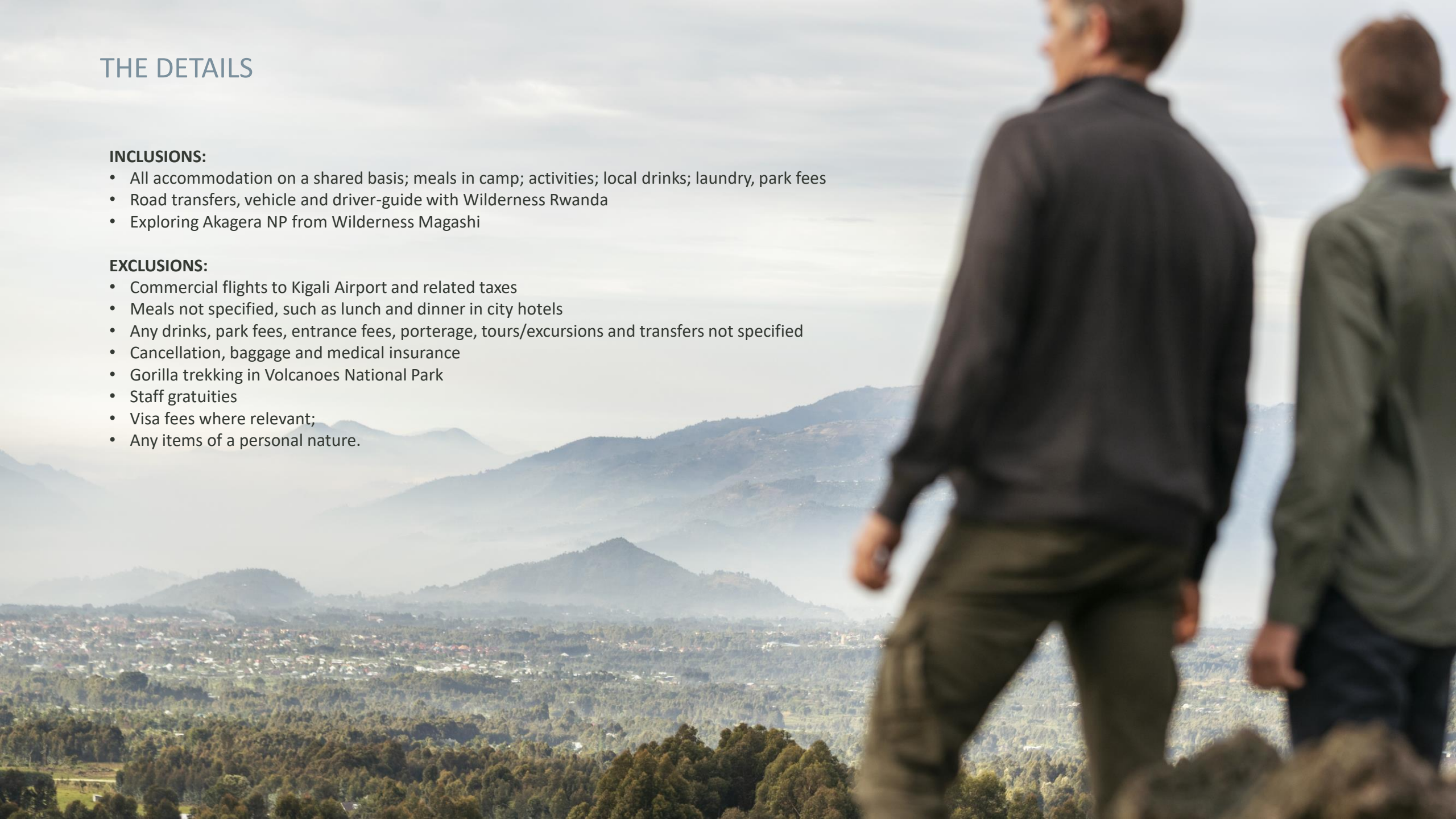
THE DETAILS

- A superb in-country combination with Bisate Reserve's gorilla trekking in Volcanoes National Park, offering a rewarding prime traditional African savannah experience.
- The only exclusive-use area in Akagera National Park, allowing for safaris facilitated by expert guides for Wilderness guests.
- Scenic and diverse habitats explored by land (day/night game drives) and water (boat) - open plains, woodlands, lakes, swamps, and hilly grassland.
- Diverse and localised wildlife species: topi and Defassa waterbuck, Masai giraffes, as well as rhinos, buffalos, elephants, lions and leopards and hippos.
- Perched on the Magashi Peninsula, Magashi looks out over picturesque Lake Rwanyakazinga, towards the Mutumba Mountains in the west.
- Magashi's intimate (just eight tents) and relaxed, but luxurious, camp is warm and welcoming. Staff love sharing their traditional fare and folklore with guests.







- Set on the edge of Volcanoes National Park (VNP), Bisate Reserve has breathtaking views of 6 volcanoes – Bisoke, Karisimbi, Mikeno, Sabyinyo, Muhabura and Gahinga – and is located at a vantage point that feels part of the park, with views over the park from the villas and main area.
- Volcanoes National Park is the best place to have engaging and personal interactions with habituated gorillas – trekking is done in small groups (up to 8), so that guests can make the most of their one-hour viewing time with their gorilla group.
- Bisate Reserve is the most intimate and exclusive high-end lodge in the Volcanoes area, and the architecture of the lodge, and the interiors of the four sublime en-suite villas, beautifully embody the traditions of Rwandan royalty and heritage.
- Bisate Kwanda Day Lounge is available to Bisate Reserve guests; the facility greatly enhances our guests’ experience and comfort by accommodating earlier arrivals and later departures, as well as offering shower and cloakroom facilities, light meals and a boutique shop for memento shopping.
- Guests can plant a tree to contribute to Bisate Reserve’s visionary reforestation project; other on-site activities include exploring the property’s nature trails and discovering the impressive diversity of habitat here; the birding is particularly rewarding, as are engaging visits with members of the local community.
- Bisate Reserve’s purpose is to protect and conserve, while providing authentic hospitality and the ability to deliver a high-end luxury service and experiences.
