Kenya Electronic Travel Authorisation system

Governors' Camp Collection has shared the following current information with us regarding visas. Kindly familiarise yourself with the latest requirements.

- Kenya has replaced its eVisa system with an Electronic Travel Authorisation system (eTA), which is now operational. Apart from holders of valid Kenyan passports, holders of Kenyan Permanent Residency, valid Work Permits and Passes and Citizens of the East African Partner States, all visitors including infants and children who intend to travel to the Republic of Kenya, must have an approved eTA before the start of their journey.
- Visitors should apply for the eTA via www.etakenya.go.ke and will pay a processing fee of USD34.
- All eTA applications for Kenya should be submitted at least 3 days prior to travel, to ensure adequate time for authorisation.
- It is highly recommended that travellers apply as soon as they have booked their accommodation and flight tickets, and we suggest that families apply as a group.
