**LAM Mozambique Airlines** has undergone a recent restructuring process and is currently expanding its routes and connections, having launched its Maputo-Lisbon flight last month.

- The three times weekly flights to Cape Town depart Maputo on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays, and returns from Cape Town on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.
  - In addition, the airline recently established flights between Johannesburg and Inhambane, Vilanculos and Beira, with plans to launch a flight between Johannesburg's Lanseria Airport and Mozambique's Xai-Xai. It has also recently launched flights to Lusaka in Zambia, which includes a stop-over in Harare.
