<b>Destination:</b>	<b>Wilderness Chitabe – Okavango Delta</b>
<b>Participants:</b>	Ella Rambau, Cindy Sewraj, Kelifilwe Molongwa, Naseera Viljoen
Suits which type of traveller:	Families with older children (as there are no family rooms,) honeymooners, single travellers, couples, and groups if taking sole use of the camp
Recommended activities:	Game drives and guided nature walks
Cuisine:	Buffet-style dining with boma evenings on Mondays. Excellent catering for dietary requirements.
Highlights during visit/stay:	Excellent guiding and game viewing Botswana Independence Day celebrations were wonderful with a boma dinner. The camp staff entertained guests with singing and dancing, and everyone was in a celebratory mood.

Highlights during visit/stay:	The rooms are beautifully appointed. The staff are very flexible and made sure we got to experience all the activities. The mokoro was extremely relaxing and the highlight of our stay. We also loved the colours used throughout the lodge as it gave it a fresher and more modern feel (not the typical safari lodge décor).

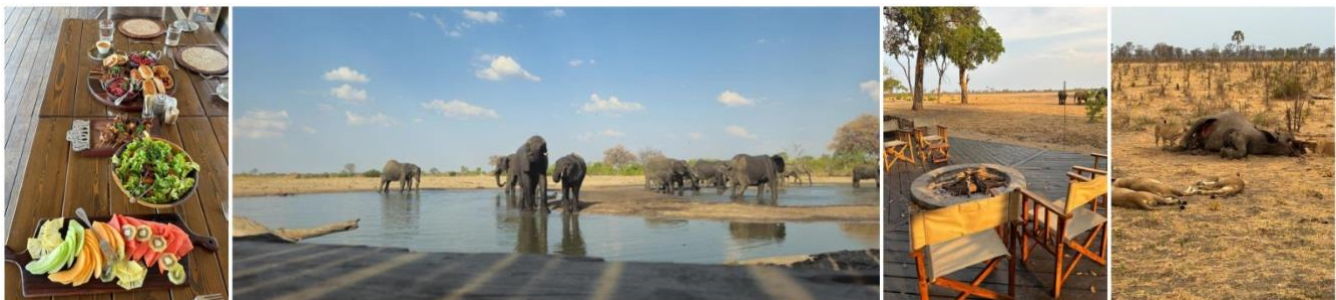


**Zimbabwe**

Suits which type of traveller:	Great for couples, families and elephant lovers
Recommended activities:	Boat cruise and game drives
Cuisine:	All meals are made from fresh produce, and the breakfasts are particularly amazing
Highlights during visit/stay:	Sundowners on the banks of the Zambezi River after our boat cruise, beautiful up-close elephant encounters, and the way the camp comes alive with the sounds of hyenas, elephants and hippos in the evening

There was also plenty of other wildlife sightings at the waterhole, including buffalo, giraffe and zebras. Another highlight was seeing the Linkwasha Pride feasting on an elephant.

Suits which type of traveller:	Couples, families and small groups
Recommended activities:	Boat cruise, rhino trekking, and guided tour of the Victoria Falls
Cuisine:	Great food selection, especially enjoyed the oxtail and pizza
Highlights during visit/stay:	Rhino trekking, walking around the Falls, and a beautiful sunset during the Zambezi cruise
