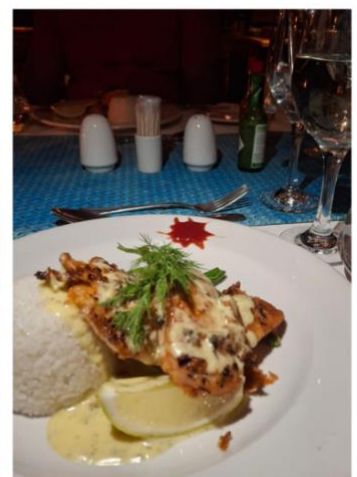

<b>Destination:</b>	<b>Wilderness Shumba Camp, Kafue National Park, Zambia</b>
<b>Participants:</b>	<b>Nosipho Mfundisi, Heinrich Jacobs, Sizwe Mkhize, Kefilwe Marumo</b>
Suits which type of traveller:	Great for couples, families, people with a desire to see lions (the camp name means lion in a Southern Africa dialect, and there are plenty here)
Recommended activities:	We participated in these activities at Shumba – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Game drives are offered as part of the fully inclusive package at Shumba</li> <li>• Bush lunches</li> <li>• Sundowners at a waterhole (gin tasting and snacks)</li> </ul>
Cuisine:	Wholesome, home-style meals
