However, in 2011, an exciting opportunity arose when his former employer at Wild Frontiers Zimbabwe invited him to join a new venture. This led to him becoming their main guide, conducting safaris across national parks in Zimbabwe, as well as exploring opportunities further afield in Zambia and Botswana.

In 2014, Tendayi acquired his professional guide's license, marking the beginning of a journey of self-exploration on foot. Despite industry shifts, including the closure of Wild Frontiers Zimbabwe operations, his dedication to guiding remained unwavering. Upon his return to Wilderness in 2017 as a Professional Guide at Linkwasha, he not only continued his guiding duties, but also embraced the role of training aspirant and junior guides.

At Linkwasha, Tendayi has been instrumental in mentoring learners from various camps across Zimbabwe, ensuring they are well-prepared for their final exams and maintaining the highest guiding standards for Wilderness, and the country as a whole. Beyond his guiding prowess, he has developed a keen interest in photography over the years, capturing the beauty of the natural world around him.
