AIRLINES

AirKenya has had the privilege of offering seamless safari itineraries connecting the Masai Mara with Uganda's national parks over the past few years. They have been able to showcase the immense beauty and wildlife of two diverse landscapes with one seamless connection through AirKenya Express and AeroLink Uganda. Unfortunately, the traffic on the route has plateaued and the numbers cannot sustain a scheduled operation. As a result, AirKenya has made the difficult decision to discontinue its scheduled services.

To ensure minimal disruption, they have put the following arrangements in place for 2025:

- **June, July, and August:** Early bookings are encouraged, though reservations will continue as normal.
- September, October, and 15 to 31 December: New bookings were suspended on 14 February 2025.
 All reservations made by this date will be honoured under existing terms and conditions.
- **Final Flights:** The last scheduled service on this route will operate on 31 December 2025.
- Minimum Passenger Requirement: The minimum passenger numbers to operate the route remains 4 passengers per sector.

NAMIBIA

The Windhoek Country Club Resort has announced the construction of a new Pool Deck Bar & Restaurant, which began in January 2025, and is expected to be completed by September 2025. The pool will be closed from June to September.

SOUTH AFRICA

TANZANIA

Zuri Zanzibar has announced some changes to their 2025 rates and offers:
