Ellerman House has launched a new fine-dining restaurant, **Curate**, alongside their One Eighty Restaurant. At the helm of Curate is Ellerman House's Head Chef Kieran Whyte. The new restaurant is situated in the iconic Wine Gallery at Ellerman House – an immersive space that serves not only as a showcase for fine wine, but as a living art installation in its own right.

Thornybush Saseka Tented Camp will undergo a temporary closure from 28 January to 13 April 2026. This planned closure is part of an exciting evolution of the camp as they enhance their offerings to provide an even more exceptional safari experience.

Here's what to look forward to:

- a new dining room and boma;
- beautiful new natural wood decking throughout the suites and main area;
- Little Saseka will be expanded to accommodate 6 guests, making it the perfect **exclusive-use retreat** for families or small groups seeking privacy and flexibility.

Kambaku Safari Lodge will close due to refurbishments from 03 February to 16 March 2026. The focus will be on enhancing the creature comforts you have come to expect from Kambaku, creating an even more inviting and elevated experience for our guests.

Lion Sands Ivory Lodge will reopen on 22 September 2025 with exciting enhancements featuring several new additions to enrich your stay, including:

- a wine room & deli;
- botanical house reception;
- safari lounge;
- open-air water closet;
- artist residency;
- fire deck.

Fish Eagle Residence will reopen on 22 September 2025 with updates that include:

- a third en-suite bedroom;
- expanded viewing and fire decks;
- a new arrival platform;
- wine room and back-of-house kitchen for an elevated, private-dining experience. Looking forward to welcoming you back to a refreshed and reimagined Ivory Lodge.

Lion Sands Kruger National Park has the following updates:

• new Mack & Madi kids' facility at Tinga Lodge;



- creative lab for keen photographers at Tinga Lodge;
- planning new three-bedroom residence at Tinga Lodge to open in July 2026;
- a never-before-seen dining venue on the Sabie River.

Inyati Game Lodge will temporarily close for refurbishment from 09 April to 30 June 2026. They will be upgrading the facilities to further enhance the guest experience and ensure even more memorable stays in future.

Londolozi and Mala Mala have partnered with Federal Airlines to streamline air traffic by coordinating shared use of airstrips. To minimise environmental impact and enhance guest experience, only pressurised aircraft – specifically the Beechcraft 1900, Pilatus PC-12, and King Air 200 – will be used. Cessna Caravans will no longer operate on this route.

Landing Protocol:

- Beechcraft 1900: Lands at Londolozi;
- Pilatus PC-12 / King Air 200: Land at Mala Mala, unless there are no Mala Mala guests then they land at Londolozi.

Passenger Grouping:

Guests traveling to Londolozi and Mala Mala will be grouped together for flight-planning purposes.

Flight Schedule:

- Departure from OR Tambo (JNB): 11:30 → Arrival: 12:30;
- Return Departure: 12:45 → Arrival at OR Tambo: 13:45.

Transfer Times to Lodges:

- Londolozi: Approximately 5 minutes;
- Mala Mala: Approximately 10–15 minutes.

Additional Services:

Lodge hops and flights to/from Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport (KMIA) will continue as scheduled, utilising their respective independent airstrips.
