**Etihad Airways** is planning to boost its services to South Africa from 30 March 2025. The airline will operate four flights per week between Abu Dhabi and Johannesburg, on Sundays, Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

From 01 August 2025, the airline will increase frequencies to daily. The flight schedule is as follows: Flight EY748 departs Johannesburg at 09h55 and arrives in Abu Dhabi at 19h50. The return flight EY747 departs Abu Dhabi at 02h20 and arrives in Johannesburg at 08h35.

**Federal Airlines** has launched a Londolozi direct service and bookings can be made directly, or through the FedAir online booking system. The flight departs from FedAir's private terminal (hangar), so all arriving guests will be transferred via their shuttle vehicles to the FedAir hanger facilities. The Meet & Assist team will hand guests over to the FedAir team, who will then take them across to their terminal.

**SACAA Changes & Federal Air's Commitment.** Due to new SACAA Regulation 139 Subpart 5, Federal Air has paused flights to unlicensed or unapproved runways until they meet updated safety standards. While compliance lies with runway owners, Federal Air is actively supporting their efforts and working closely with SACAA, who are now assisting with approvals as soon as they can. Along with others in the industry, they are lobbying in the background to get all runways approved as quickly as possible.

#### To ensure continued seamless service:

- **Approved runways:** Where available, flights will operate to the nearest licensed runway with road transfers arranged.
- **No approved runway:** Road transfers from Johannesburg to lodges will be provided, maintaining expected comfort and service.

**LATAM Airlines Brazil** has expanded its codeshare agreement with South African carrier Airlink, adding four new African destinations to its network via Johannesburg. Brazilian travellers can now book single-ticket itineraries to Harare (Zimbabwe), Maputo (Mozambique), Windhoek (Namibia) and Dar es Salaam (Tanzania). This extension enables passengers departing from Brazil to travel to up to eight destinations in Africa with checked baggage included.

	Upon arrival, we were greeted with refreshing drinks and a taste of their Chenin Blanc wine. The Hazendal Hotel offers various dining options: The Restaurant in the hotel focuses on fine cuisine, the Deli is a tapas-style experience, The Eatery offers open-fire cooking, pizzas, and craft beer. There is also a bar, clubhouse and great picnics. A highlight is the Sensory Experience, which includes a cellar tour and tutored wine-pairing in the elegant subterranean Wine Library. Each wine is paired with a flavour-packed micro plate presented in a beautiful ceramic and glass tower.
	We were impressed by how they have preserved the historical buildings and vintage cars, as well as the owner's collection of cigars and spirits in the Cigar Lounge. For movie lovers or gamers, the Cinema Room is a great option. My highlight was the beautifully decorated Library reading room, along with the diverse art throughout the corridors and gallery. Golf enthusiasts will enjoy the Pro Shop. Private wine tastings.
