


Botswana

- An oasis within the desert, it offers a **profusion of game**, predators and exceptional birds.







The Okavango Delta

- **Finest multi-purpose concession** in the Okavango Delta for wildlife and land and water activities year-round.
- The beauty of the floodplains, deep waterways, and riverine and island woodlands, as well as productive, dry interior, are explored through an extensive range of activities: day and night game drives, nature walks, boating, mokoro, hot air ballooning and helicopter rides.
- The extent of habitat is well illustrated in the diversity of antelopes and vast array of large – and small – predators (lion prides, African wild dogs, leopards and occasional cheetah, raptors) resulting in an immensely rich and thrilling wildlife experience.






The Linyanti

- Home to the **highest concentration of elephants** in Africa, the Linyanti is Africa's ultimate elephant conservation area.
- This is due to the Linyanti's unique situation at the intersection of three rivers a vital water- and food source and its position in the heart of the greater (unfenced) Kavango-Zambezi Transfrontier Conservation Area.
- With access to the fertile Kwando/Chobe ecosystem, the enormous 125 000hectare Linyanti Wilderness Reserve boasts the greatest habitat diversity and game viewing in northern Botswana.
- The habitats include marshes and waterways, riverine woodland, Kalahari apple-leaf and cathedral-like mopane woodlands, as well as grasslands.





UNIQUE SELLING POINTS

Mababe

- Distinctly unique for Botswana, 55,000-hectare Mababe is the exclusive home to
 one of three distal lakes of the Okavango, where three habitat types converge: the
 marsh (wetland) system of some 2,600 hectares fed by the perennial Mababe River,
 mopane and acacia woodlands, and the immense grassland plains.
- Being the closest to permanent water for hundreds of miles to the east, north and south, the area attracts numerous species' mega-herd aggregations, as well as great general diversity of other wildlife, all drawn to the life-giving waters and sustenance of the nutrient-rich grassland.
- Superherds of buffalo and other big herbivores, alongside high densities of lion
 prides and large hyena clans, result in a highly intense predator-prey dynamic.
 Hunts often play out in daylight (into the late mornings) on the open plains, which
 makes for easy visuals and impressive photographic opportunities. Cheetah also
 seen in good numbers.
