- An **all-in-one in-country safari circuit**, with gorilla, chimpanzee and golden monkey trekking in the west and an exceptional savannah experience in the east, where tree-climbing lions, leopard, elephant and other large game roam.
- Located within a branch of the spectacularly beautiful and life-filled Great Rift Valley known as the Albertine Rift, the land of a thousand hills – as Rwanda is aptly nicknamed – is a **prolific biodiversity and endemism hotspot**.

Volcanoes National Park

- Volcanoes National Park (VNP) is the best place to have engaging and **personal interactions with habituated gorillas.**
- Trekking is done in **small private groups**, and you can get to within several metres of the gentle giants.
- Other primates include the comically entertaining **golden monkeys**; a haven of rainforest endemism, around 16 of the approximately 200 bird species are only found in the Albertine Rift.

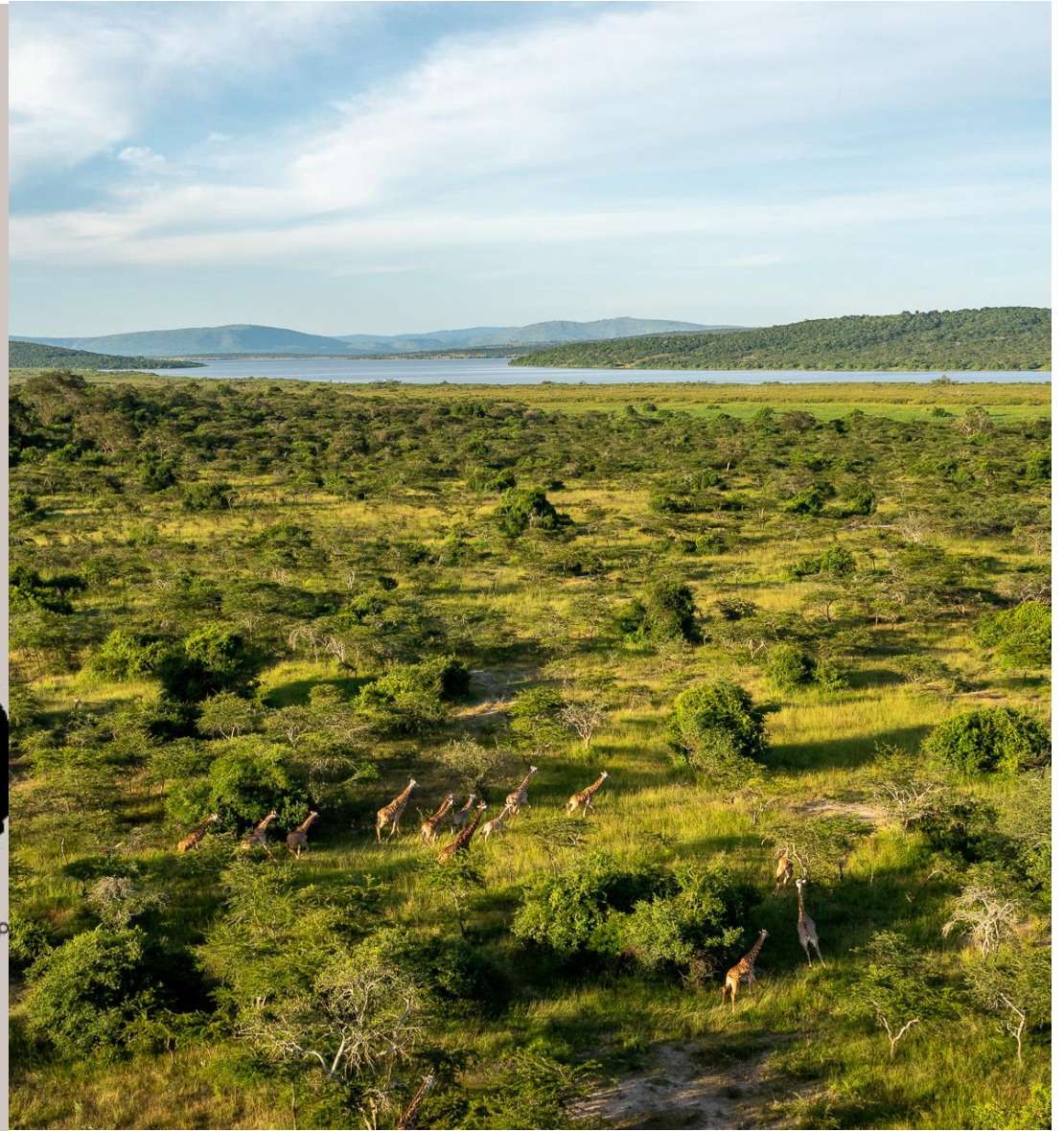

Akagera National Park

- Akagera National Park is Central Africa's largest protected wetland and the last remaining refuge for savannah-adapted species in Rwanda.
- Due to its phenomenally diverse habitats, Akagera is a prime savannah game viewing area, with a vast array of localised plains game such as topi and Defassa waterbuck, and Masai giraffes, as well as rhinos, buffalos, elephants, lions and leopards, to be seen.
- It is also home to one of Africa's highest hippo densities and some very large crocodiles.
- Specials include the secretive sitatunga and rare shoebill stork.
