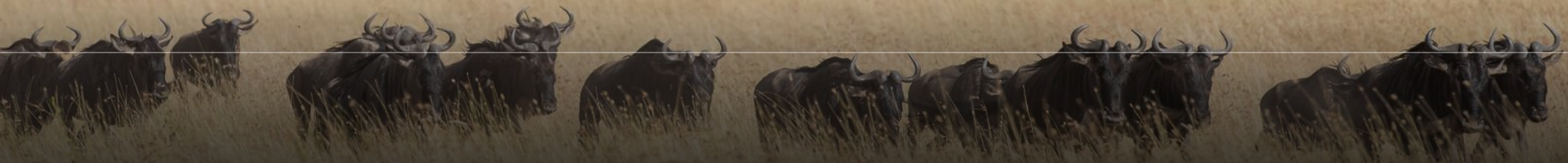

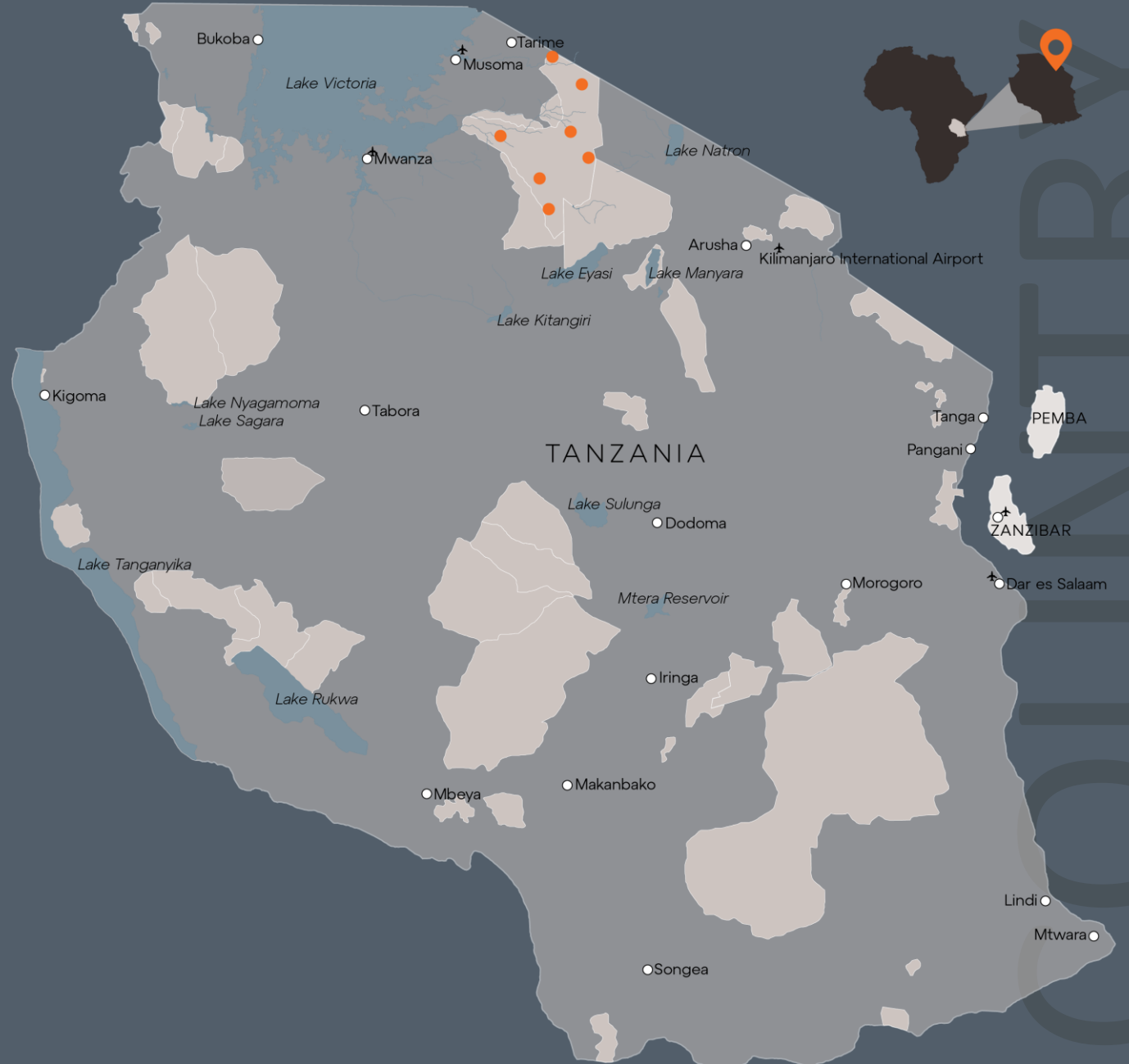

# Tanzania

- Host to one of the greatest wildlife spectacles on Earth: the Great Migration.
- Home to iconic African landmarks Mount Kilimanjaro and the Ngorongoro Crater, as well as aquamarine seas with white sandy islands and beaches, offering a complete wilderness experience.
- Tanzania is home to 7 UNESCO World Heritage Sites – 3 natural sites (Kilimanjaro, Nyerere and Serengeti national parks), 3 cultural sites (Kondoa Rock-Art Sites, Ruins of Kilwa Kisiwani and Ruins of Songo Mnara, Stone Town in Zanzibar) and one mixed site (Ngorongoro Conservation Area).
- Tanzania has extraordinary natural diversity, including tropical and subtropical forest, savannah and shrubland, tropical and subtropical grassland, flooded grassland and savannah, montane grassland and shrubland, and two aquatic biomes – mangrove and fresh water.
- Meet the Maasai of the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, a culture internationally recognised for their distinctive rituals, traditional dress, and reputation for being courageous warriors.

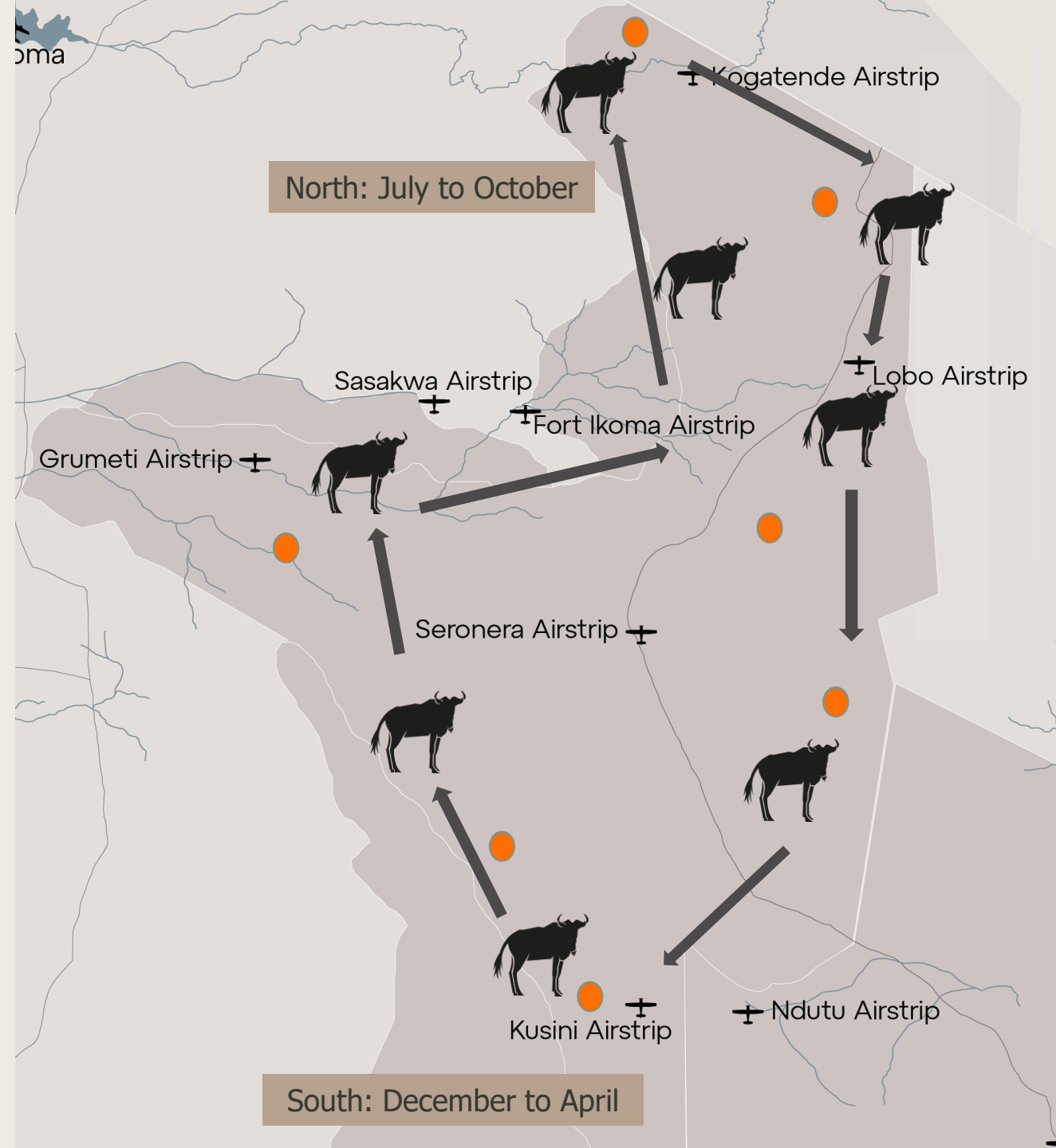

# Africa's greatest spectacle

- The Great Migration is the **largest herd movement of animals on Earth**, Africa's greatest spectacle.
- **Two million wildebeest, zebra, Thomson's gazelle, topi and other herbivores** move across the Serengeti-Mara ecosystem in search of nutritious grazing grounds and water.
- **Traversing the breadth of the plains** here, the animals focus intently on heading to the north of the park; they then take the long journey back south again, breeding and birthing along the way.
- More than **300,000 births and dozens of death-defying river crossings** mean constant predator-prey interaction on the Serengeti's plains – providing a banquet for lions, hyenas and crocodiles.

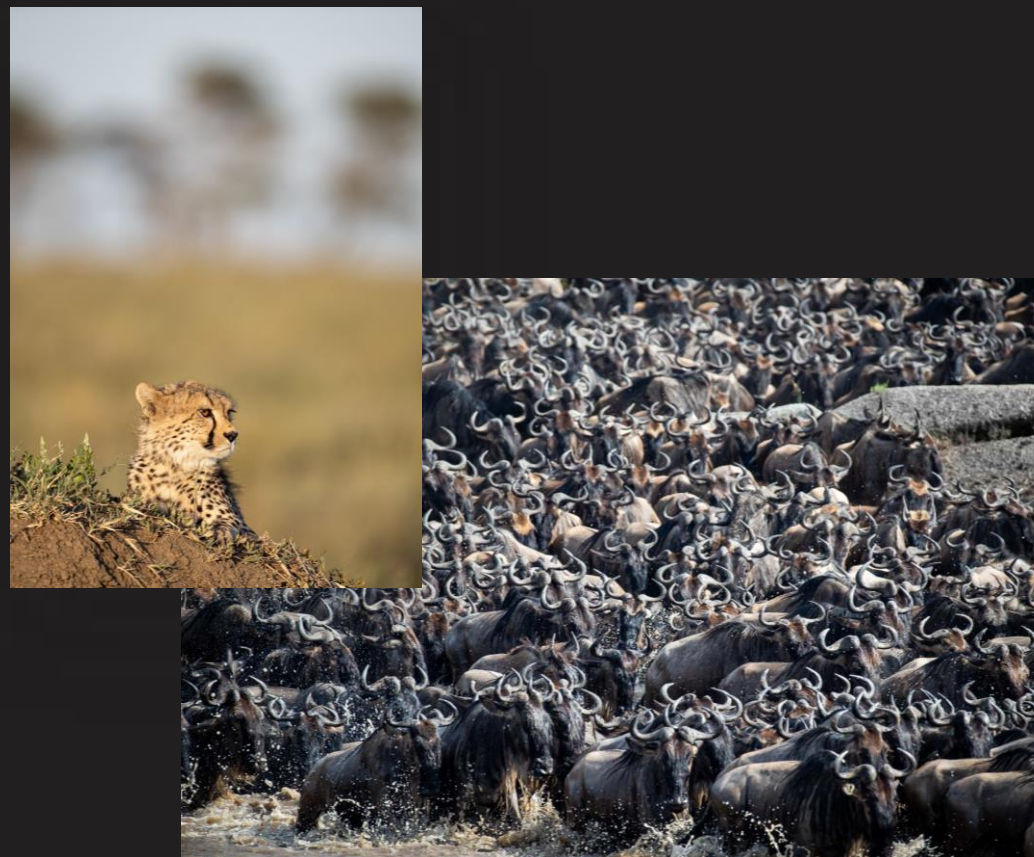

# The Serengeti

- At 15,000 km<sup>2</sup>, Serengeti National Park is one of the seven Natural Wonders of Africa, and home to the Great Migration. Here 2 million wildebeest, zebra and Thomson's gazelles journey through the park, prey to a variety of predators, including lions, hyenas and crocodiles.
- The Ngorongoro Crater, a large inactive caldera covering an area of 300 km<sup>2</sup>, is home to a high density of wildlife – close to 25,000 large mammals, including black rhino, Cape buffalo, eastern white-bearded wildebeest, zebra and eland.
