Updated Visa Requirements Waiver

Citizens of 53 additional countries are now exempt from visa requirements to enter Zambia. Starting from 1 January 2025, nationals from 167 countries can enter Zambia, continuing the liberalisation process started in 2022, which removed visa requirements for major tourism markets.
