Ubuyu, a new Banyan Tree Escape in Tanzania will be open for stays from May 2026.

- Located in Ruaha National Park, the property will feature six one-bedroom villas, as well as a two- and three-bedroom villa all overlooking the park's Great Ruaha River.
- Ranging in size from 245-425 square metres, each of the villas will feature a private pool, viewing decks and open-air shows. The three-bedroom villa boasts a courtyard with a firepit, five decks, an infinity pool and a rooftop relaxation area. Shared spaces and amenities will include an open-air living area and kitchen, a rooftop bar and restaurant, a spa and a swimming pool with a deck.
- Guests will have a dedicated Escape Host to organise activities and tailor stays. Activities include game drives, walking safaris, hot air ballooning, traditional cooking classes, outdoor dining experiences and rock art tours.

Zanzibar White Sand underwent significant enhancements in 2025, reinforcing their position as Tanzania's only Relais & Châteaux property and recent Michelin Key status.

- Each villa has been refreshed and repainted, and the beachfront villas have undergone balcony renovations.
- The Senses Spa has been completely renovated to create an open, expansive environment that emphasises the natural beauty surrounding it.
- The air-conditioned Fitness Centre has been refurbished with state-of-the-art Technogym equipment for strength and cardio training. The facility is designed to accommodate different fitness levels and goals.
- Wheelchair accessibility has been enhanced throughout the property, with accessible pathways around the resort and access to the pools.
- The resort now features a new padel court in addition to the existing tennis court.
- A new yoga platform has been constructed on the beach, comfortably accommodating 8-10 participants for wellness sessions in an oceanfront setting.

The Zanzibar Collection has advised that The Palms & Zawadi Hotel will be closed during the 2026 low season as part of their annual closure process for enhancement and refurbishment.

- The Palms will be closed from 06 May to 04 June 2026 (re-opens on 05 June 2026)
- Zawadi Hotel will be closed from 05 April to 04 May 2026 (re-opens on 05 May 2026)
- During this time Baraza Resort & Spa, the flagship property, as well as Breezes Beach Club & Spa will remain open and fully operational.

Nomad Tanzania's new Kusini Serengeti Camp welcomed its first guests in December 2025.

- Located in the Southern Serengeti, the area is perfect to experience the migration from December to March but see resident game in the dry season.
- The camp is set in among granite kopjes, offering six large, open plan canvas tents on raised platforms with en-suite bathrooms including flush toilets and showers, and with a private veranda.
- The camp offers game drives, walking safaris straight from camp or into further afield areas of the park, sundowners, cookout bush breakfasts and dinners, and climbing the huge kopjes for sundowners and stargazing.
- The Southern Serengeti Airstrip is 15 minutes from camp for easy access.
