You can't get much closer to the renowned dunes of Sossusvlei and the evocative panoramas of Dead Vlei than Little Kulala. An exclusive-use gate provides direct access to these storied Namibian landmarks. Climb a 300-metre red dune and gaze upon the famed Namib Sand Sea World Heritage Site. Spot desert-adapted wildlife. Stargaze under one of the darkest skies on Earth. Discover peace and privacy at your private plunge pool, or over dinner on your rooftop. Later, roll out your bed to sleep under the constellations on your deck.

Remote Wilderness Hoanib Skeleton Coast Camp rests in Namibia's famed and ancient Kaokoveld. Search the rust-coloured crags and arid plains for rare wildlife. Take a thrilling drive to the wild, windswept Skeleton Coast. Hike rocky outcrops, scramble down enormous sand dunes, marvel at desert oases, and dine under impossibly starry night skies. Wilderness Hoanib Skeleton Coast Camp is a true desert oasis in a land that seems uninhabitable, yet is life-filled.


