ARGENTINA STATUS

As of today -September 16th, 2020-, Argentina is still in some sort of "lock down". We are able to leave our house and do basic shopping and mingle 2-3 friends in open spaces and bars that can offer outside seating areas. This has just started and we believe it is a good sign that things will slowly go back to normal.

Now, as per **flights**, these are still cancelled and word is spread that they will be back on **October 1st** both domestic and international but only for repatriation or for those travelling for work reasons; **no tourism allowed yet**.

Entry procedures - for those coming back to Argentina - require a 14 day quarantine.

We are still working with the Tourism Bureau and the Argentinean Chamber of Tourism in finding ways to enhance protocols and standard procedures so we can go back to receiving visitors.

We believe that this will take some time and looks like **December** might bring positive news; we do not believe that flights will be operating for tourist in November. However there is no official word on this.

The good news is that even if we still have quite a few number of cases everyday, the numbers have stabilized somehow, so there is some light at the end of the tunnel.

HIT THE ROAD

Find below our choice of road trips in Argentina

VALDES PENINSULA REVISITED

Grab a rental car and explore the Valdes Peninsula. Use this area as a base for exploring. While staying at the Valdes Peninsula (at Puerto Piramides village or at the high end Rincon Chico) minimize the traveling times to the highlights.

In a 4 day trip, enjoy the most of the area: Sea Lions and elephant seals (almost year round), penguins at San Lorenzo ranchhouse (superb rookery!), Southern right Whales (Jun through December) and dolphins in Southern summer.

As an additional - and gran finale - visit Gaiman -a Welsh origin small village- which gives a new approach to the area.



REMOTE PATAGONIA

We combine a drive from El Calafate to El Chalten, to enjoy great days hiking the classics or reaching Lago del Desierto.

Drive to Estancia La Maipu -which is maybe the best kept secret in Patagonia - a great place to do amazing outdoor experiences.

Then El Calafate and Perito Moreno glacier to keep the amazing images before leaving!



FROM THE ATLANTIC TO THE ANDES

One of the most interesting Road Trips in Argentina! Land in Comodoro Rivadavia on the Atlantic coast. Drive to the Andes crossing the legendary Patagonian steppe.

From Los Antiguos drive South towards El Calafate. On the way visit such highlights as: Cave of the Painted hands, remote lakes, the Perito Moreno National Park, enjoy remote estancias, La Maipu as a gem on the trip, El Chalten with its classics and last but not least El Calafate with its impressive Perito Moreno Glacier.
