ABOUT THE AREA

Wilderness Bisate has dramatic views of the Bisoke and Karisimbi volcano peaks rising through the forests of nearby Volcanoes National Park. It is within easy driving distance of Park Headquarters, from where once-in-a-lifetime gorilla treks depart daily. Exploring around Bisate includes community visits, birding, golden monkey tracking, and helping reforest the area, Gorilla Guardian Village, the Twin Lakes of Ruhondo and Burera, and Dian Fossey's grave.

BEST TIME TO VISIT

March to May, October & November

- Regular rainfall leaves the air clear and thus provides better photographic opportunities
- Trees and plants start to flower, encouraging birdlife

December to February, June to September

- Two dry seasons: June-August and January-February
- While some rain still falls, this is a drier time of year with less muddy and dense conditions in the forests
