BEST TIME TO TRAVEL

November to February

- A season of abundance as antelope enter calving season, and predator activity increases
- Summer migrants arrive in vibrant breeding plumage.
- Superb photographic conditions: rich light, colour, and subject matter.

April to May

- Rainfall decreases and temperatures begin to cool.
- Vegetation dries out; trees begin shedding leaves.

June to August

- · Increase in water birdlife.
- · Leafless woodlands offer excellent visibility.
- Cool, dry days with chilly mornings and evenings.

September to October

- Temperatures rise, peaking in October.
- Continued dry conditions enhance wildlife sightings as water sources dwindle.
- Occasional rainstorms mark the start of seasonal change.
- Vegetation begins to green and thicken.
- Due to lower water levels, boating may be limited.
