

Jacana

- An intimate and authentic Okavango experience with visual, tangible exposure to the seasonal Delta waters as the camp is situated on a small island.
- The semi-permanent water allows encounters with the fascinating creatures that flourish in this unique environment, from hippos, crocodiles and water-loving elephants to a wealth of waterbirds, including the emblematic African jacana.
- Numerous Okavango specials abound, including wattled crane, Pel's fishing owl, sitatunga and red lechwe.
- The essence of the Okavango is experienced while peacefully floating along its clear, quiet channels in a mokoro (traditional dugout canoe).


Travel with purpose
