

Kwetsani

- Kwetsani's position is ideal for a diverse game-viewing experience, with access to the iconic Delta waters, and thrilling land-based adventures of the savannah.
- Nearby Hunda Island the largest landmass on the Jao Reserve provides ample room for plains game such as giraffes, wildebeest, zebras and impalas, and their predators, chiefly leopards, lions and spotted hyenas.
- The surrounding floodplains are home to a number of Delta specials species that are found in few other places on Earth: endangered wattled crane, slaty egret, pink-throated longclaw, and numerous others.
- Land and water activities (water-level dependent), include game drives, mokoro and boating, allowing guests to see all aspects of the Delta's wildlife makeup. During times of high water, Kwetsani guests boat to Hunda Island for game drives, complete with a picnic on a full-day excursion.
