# Pelo

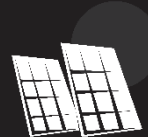
- An intimate, unpretentious camp that offers a pure water experience in the core of the Delta.
- Explore the Delta and its scenic waterways in the same way its tribal inhabitants have done over the centuries: by mokoro – a traditional dugout boat.
- Pelo means heart in Setswana – a fitting name for a camp located on a heart-shaped island in the heart of the Okavango Delta and at the heart of the experience: the water-bound wilderness.
- Pelo's low-impact, carbon-neutral activities allow unobtrusive wildlife viewing and a gentle connection with its aquatic surroundings and specialised wildlife.

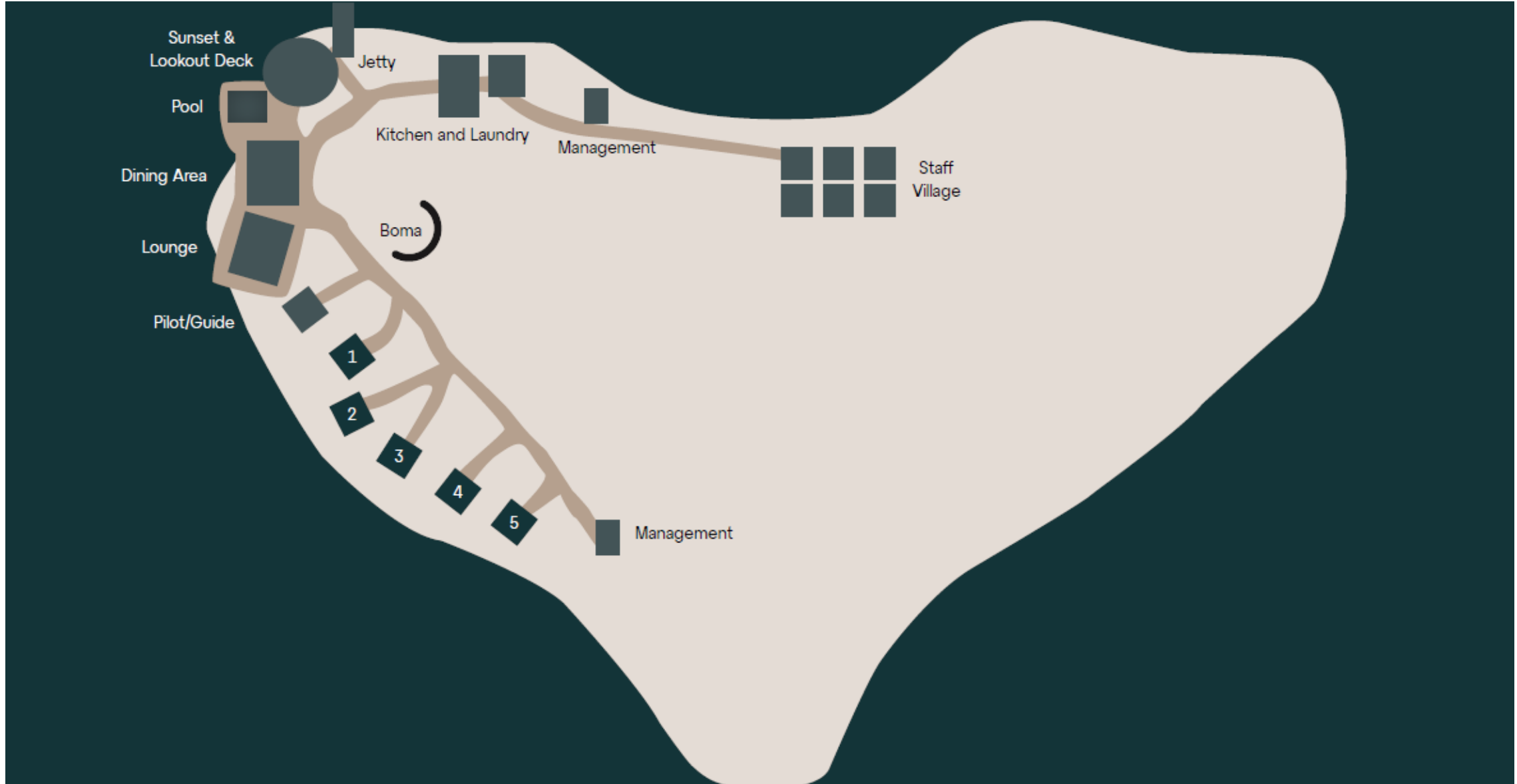
# Heart-shaped island

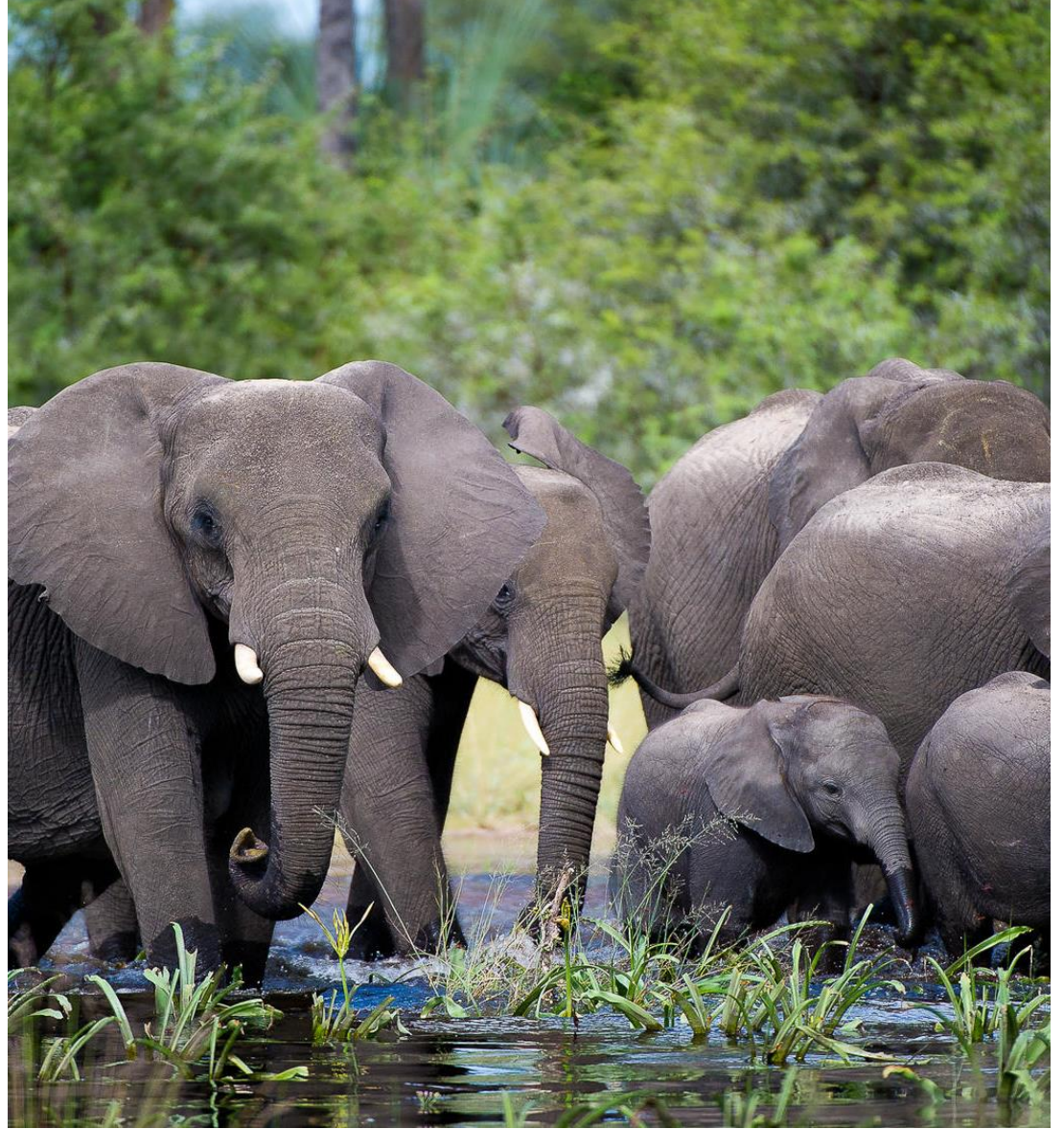
