Vumbura Plains

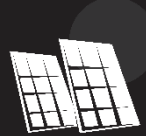
- Finest multi-purpose concession in the Okavango Delta for wildlife, and year-round land and water activities.

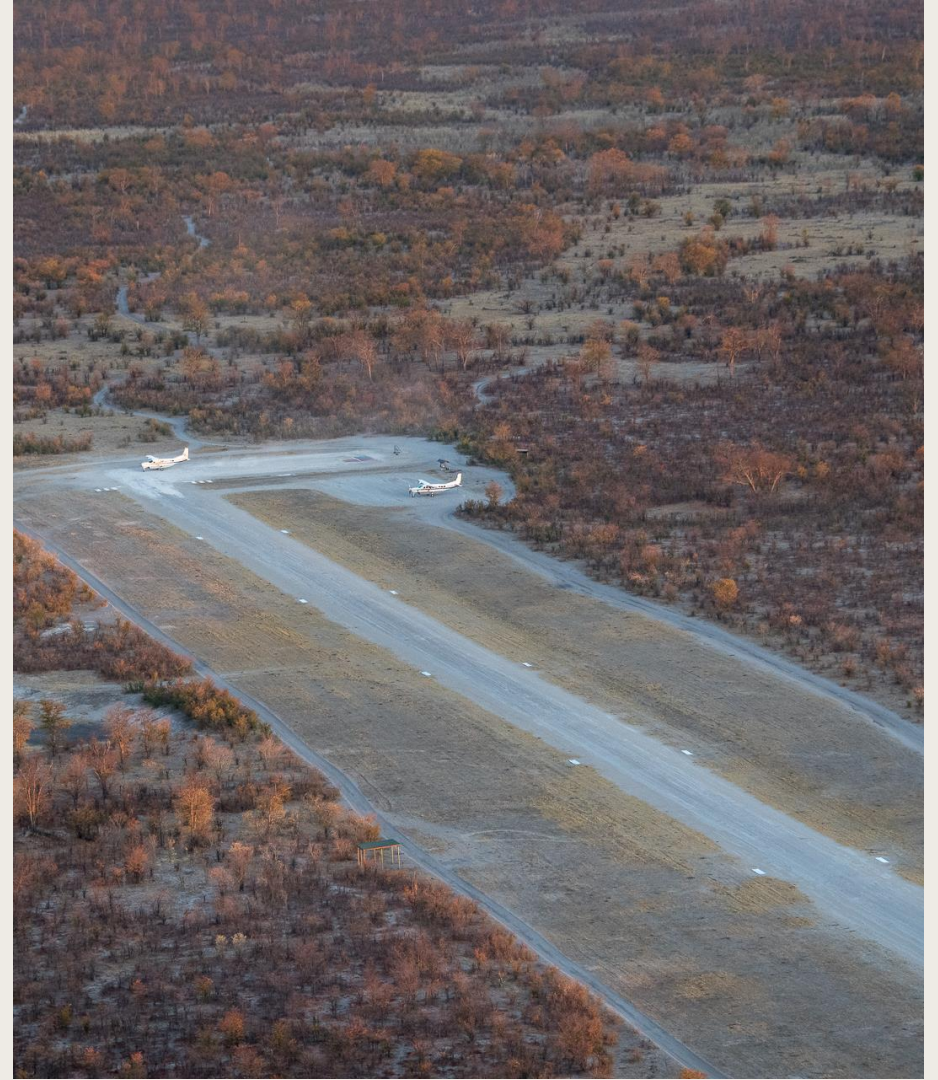

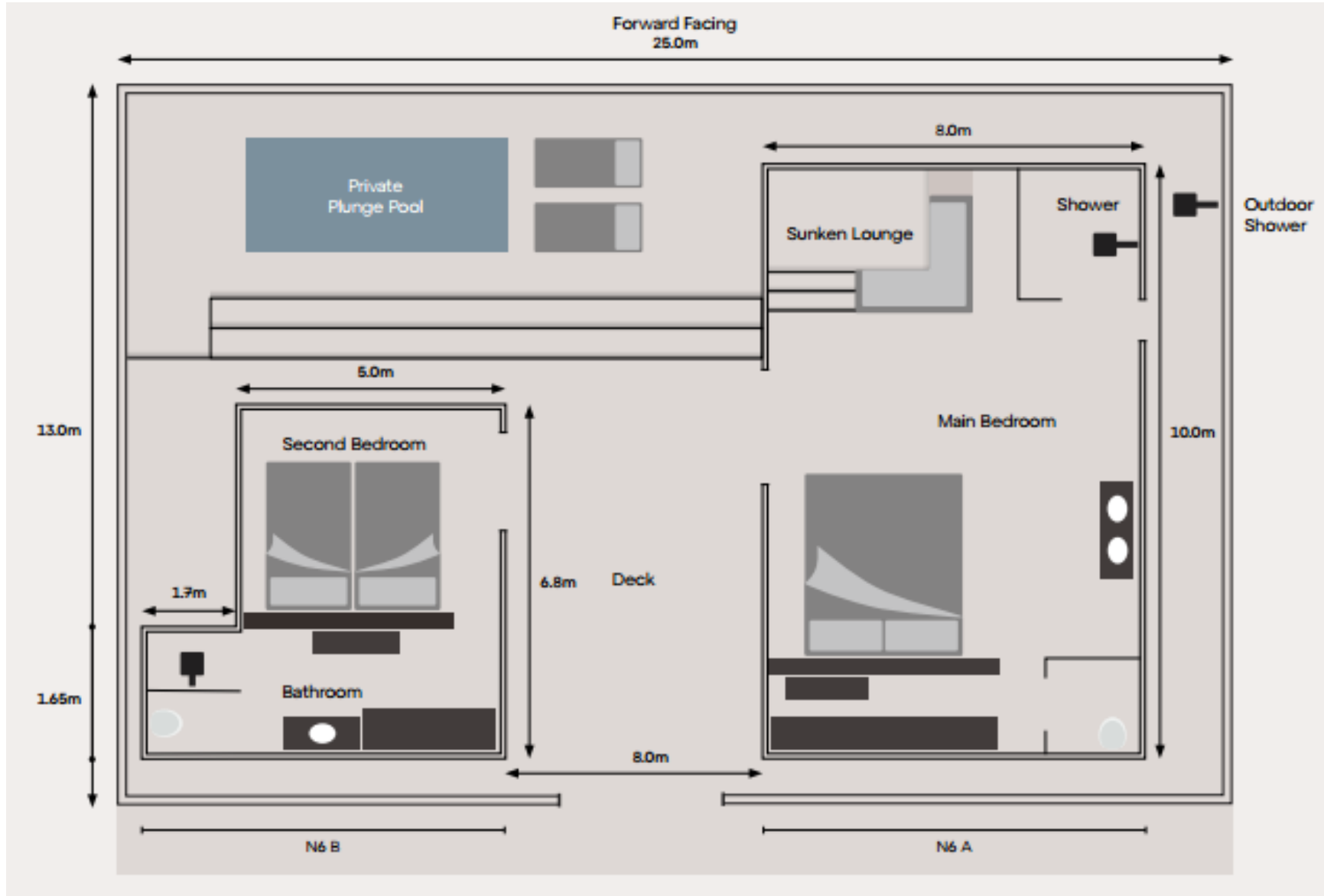
The largest number of employees within our Botswana operations are employed from these five villages.

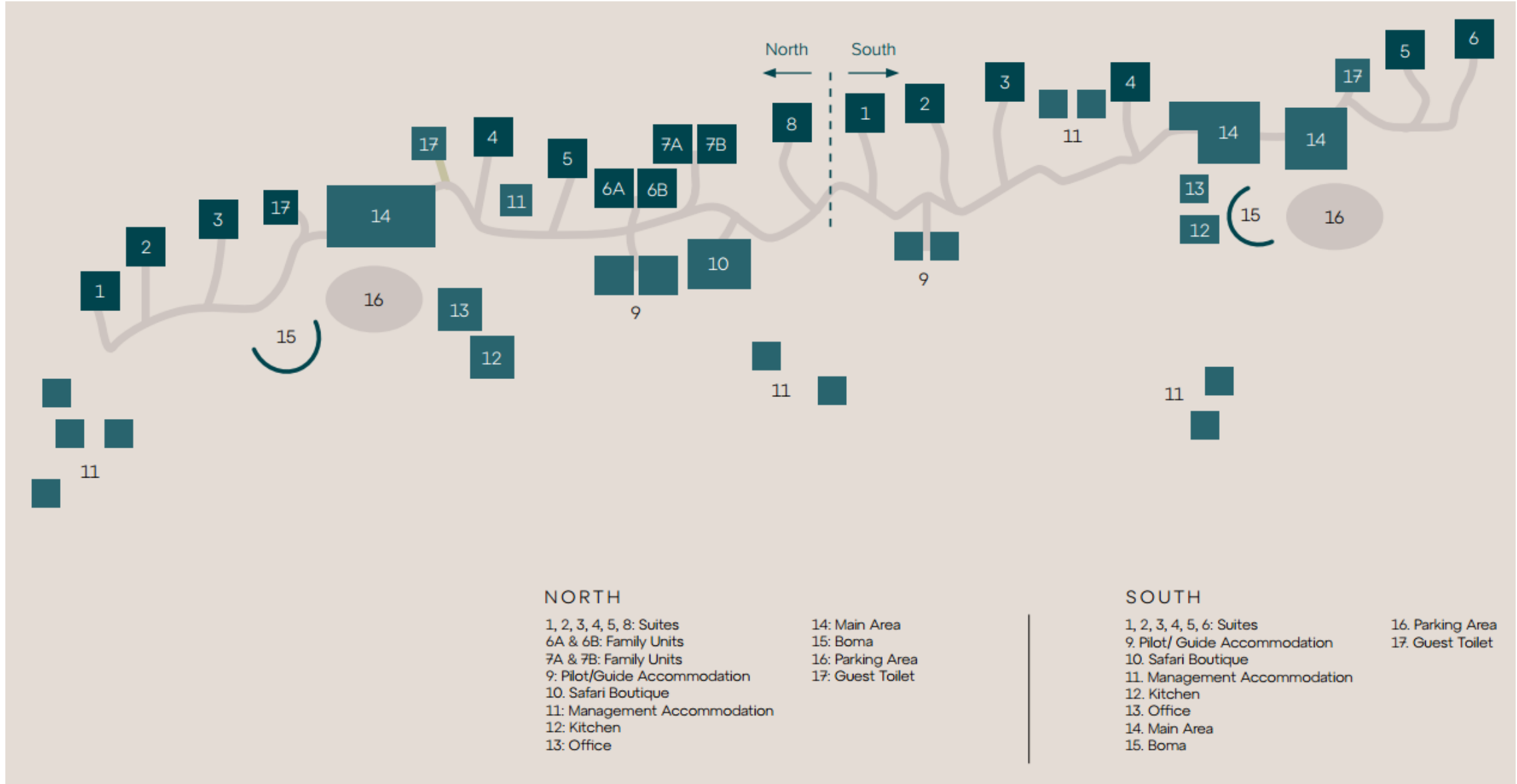
ACCOMMODATION
