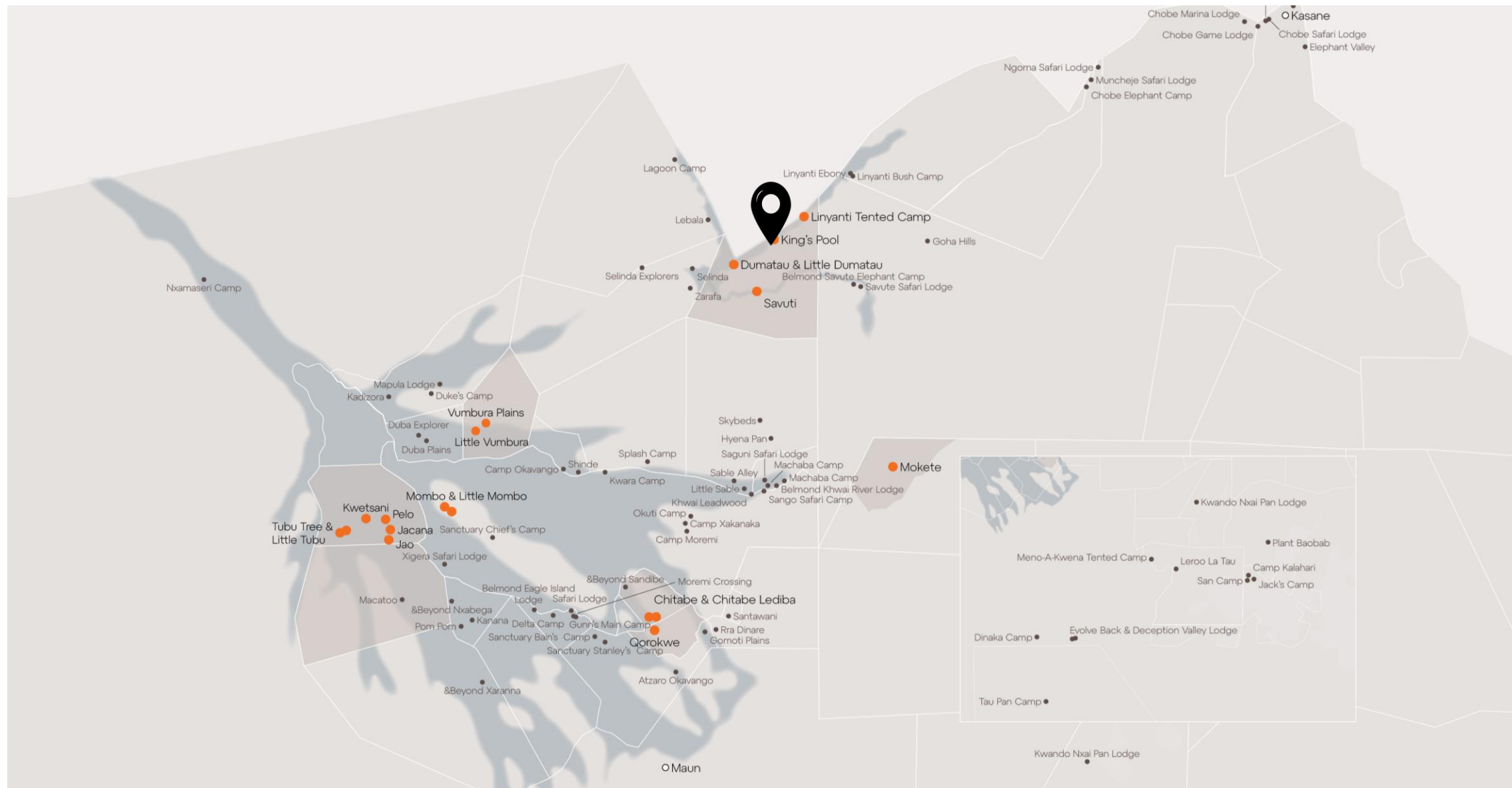

King's Pool

- King's Pool is known for its quintessential Linyanti game drives – both day and night--time, thrilling bush walks and unique helicopter flips here at the tail end of the Great Rift Valley; and equally sublime sunset boating on the Queen Silvia barge.
- However, King's Pool's one-of-a-kind eye-level waterhole at the underground hide sets it apart. Seeing elephant feet and trunks almost within touching distance is an experience that transcends an ordinary safari.
- One of the best places in Botswana to see rare sable and roan.
- The camp's position, alongside Chobe National Park and straddling four unfenced country borders, presents an unobstructed pathway for all manner of wildlife to come and go – particularly wild dogs and elephants.
- As an Important Bird Area (IBA), it is a birder's paradise; a carmine bee-eater nesting site nearby is a spectacle to behold in the summer months.

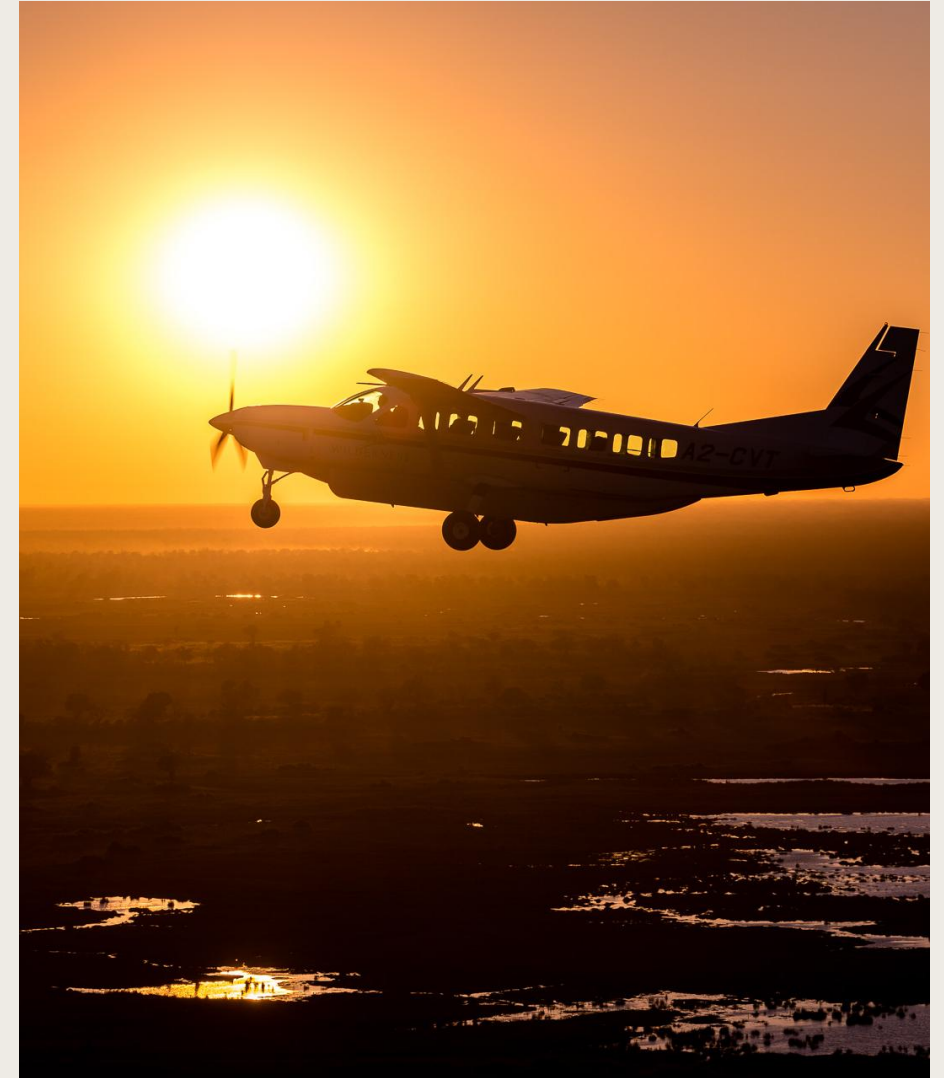

The location of King's Pool, bordering Chobe National Park and at the crux of KAZA's important wildlife corridor straddling Angola, Namibia, Zambia and Botswana, means it fulfils a vital role in the area's biodiversity conservation.

- Named for the Scandinavian royals who once holidayed here, King's Pool is a regal thatch-and-canvas camp set in the dappled shade of towering jackalberry trees.
- The camp and guest suites embrace a picturesque lagoon where all manner of wildlife dramas unfold.

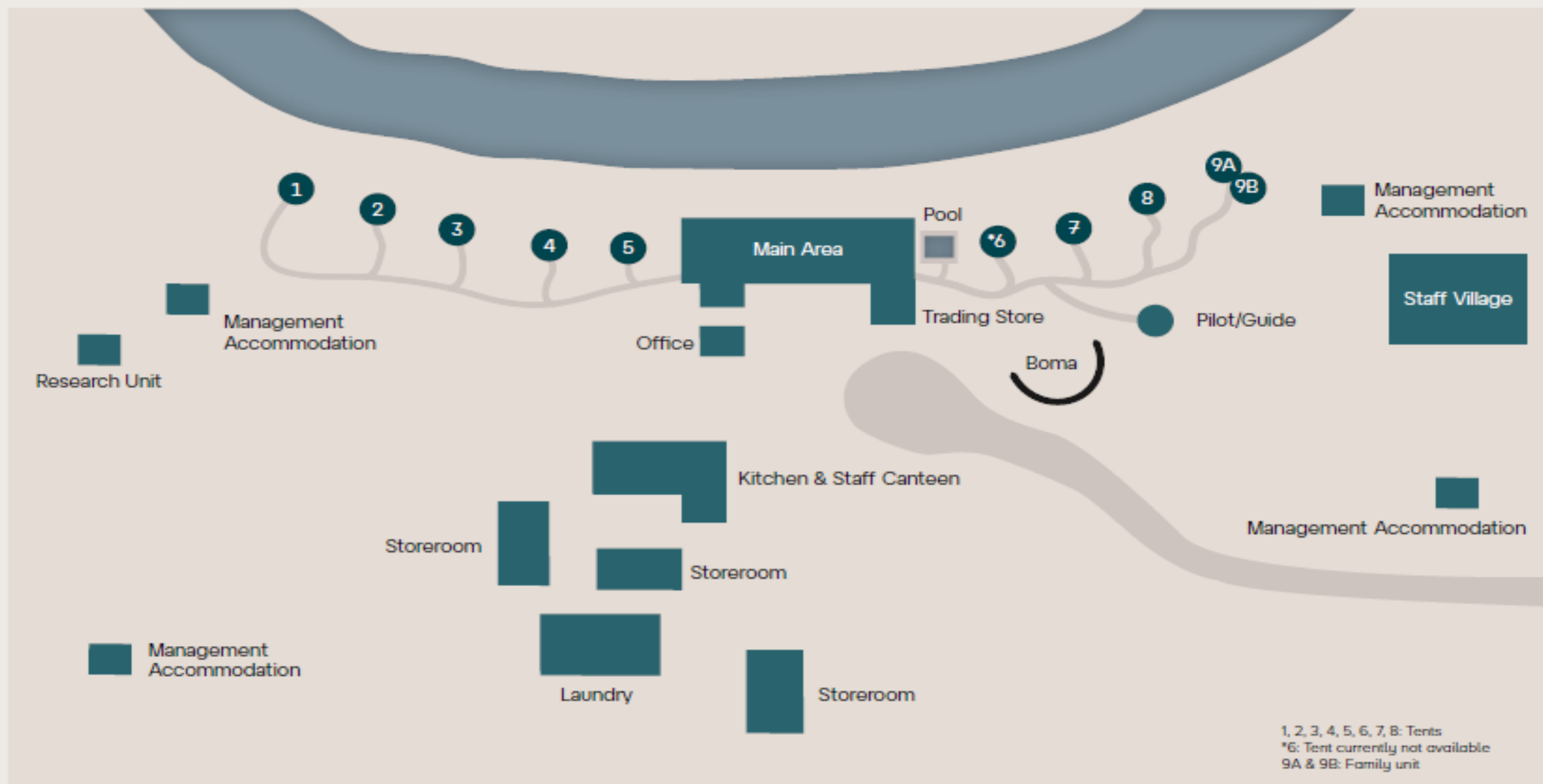



MAIN AREA & AERIAL VIEW

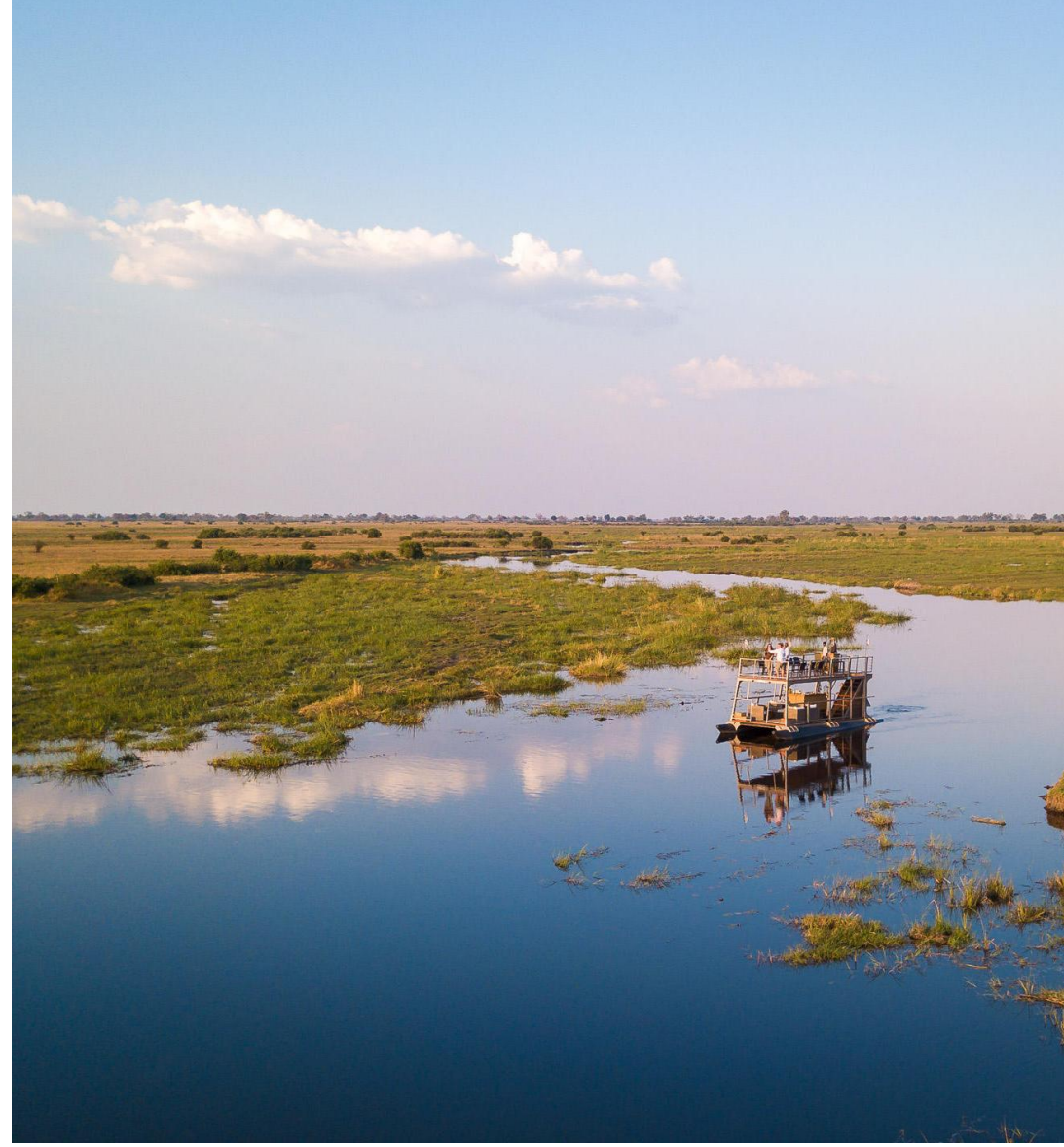

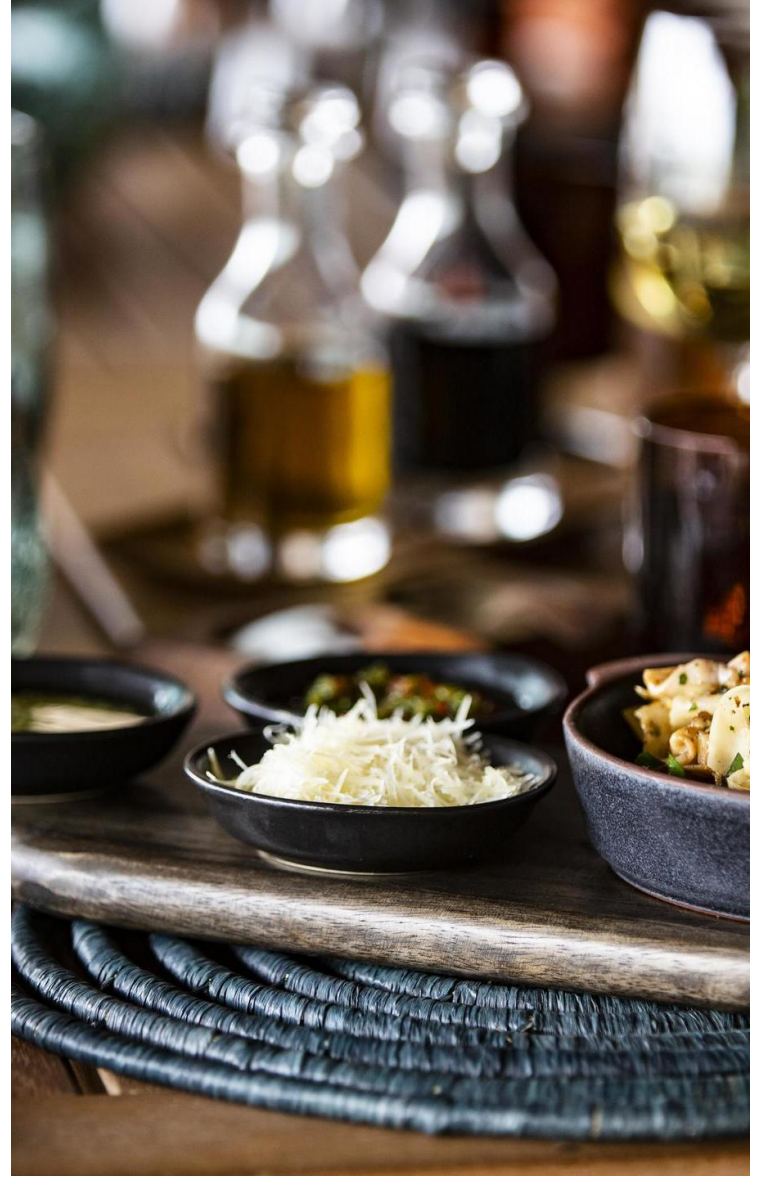
