


BUSANGA BUSH CAMP





Busanga Bush Camp

- Open for just five months each year, before the seasonal rains return to inundate the land once more, Busanga Bush Camp epitomises 'off the beaten track', offering one of the most remote and wild safaris on the planet.
- Aptly named the 'Plains of Plenty', the Busanga Plains' exceptional biodiversity draws a vast number of species into the area, which literally teems with wildlife and birds. Epic exchanges between the famous lions of the area reveal the unpredictable dynamics between the prides and the nomadic males that move through.
- With 600 square kilometres of savannah threaded with aquatic channels
 to explore, adventures include game drives, exhilarating infra-red spotlit
 night drives and boating excursions (when the water is still high).





Personal safari experience


- Ideal for small groups or a very personalised safari, Busanga Bush
 Camp is an intimate haven with just four tented suites and a main
 area looking out over the abundance of the plains. The charming
 dining area is shaded by a canopy of trees from which a delightful
 multi-lantern 'chandelier' hangs a spectacular sight when lit up at
 night.
- Witness sensational sunrises from camp, or when setting out on game drives, as the sun-tinged mist reveals hundreds of red lechwe, puku, and other plains game feeding on the grasses.
