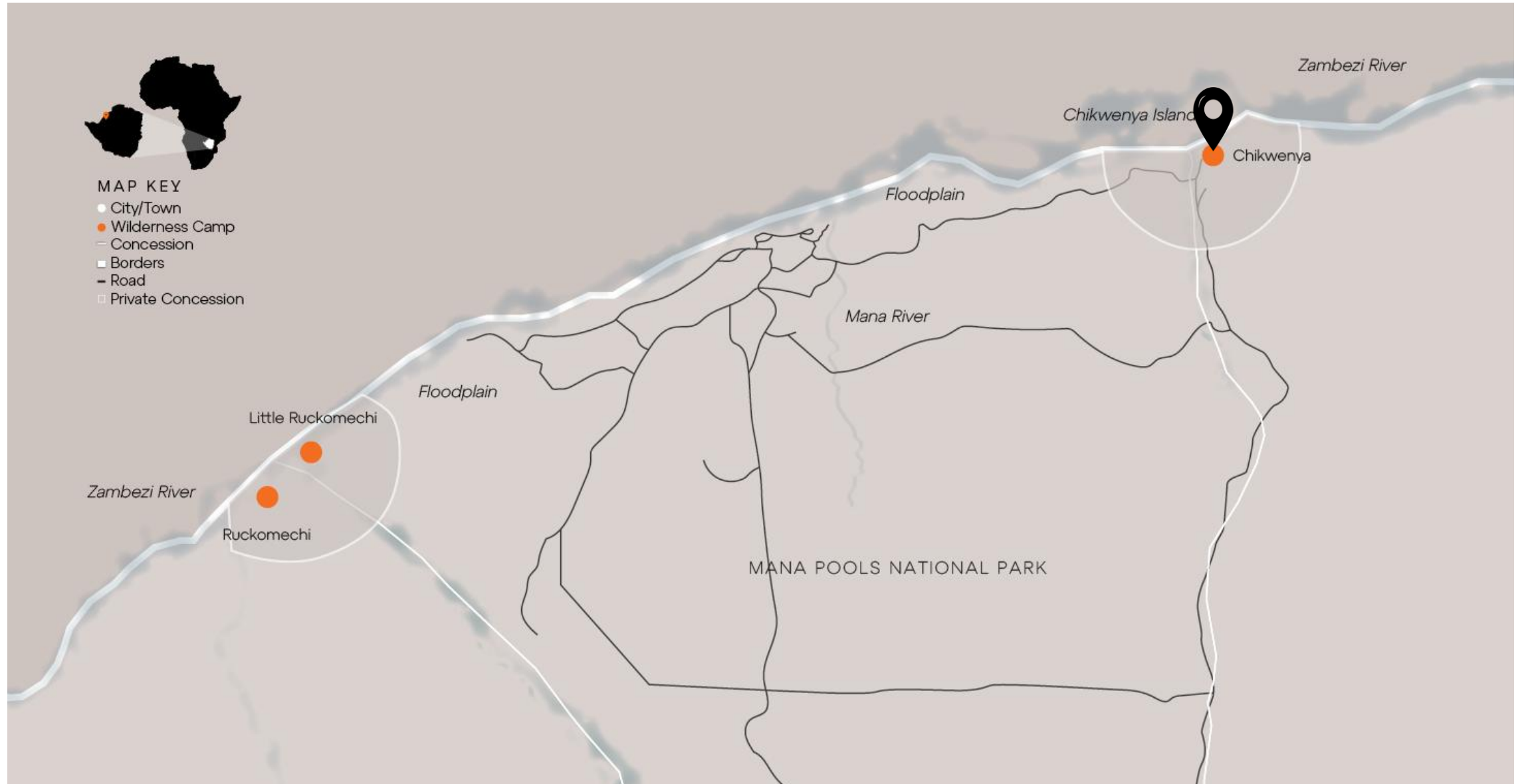

Chikwenya

- Located at the confluence of the Sapi and Zambezi rivers in an exclusive, private wilderness area on Mana Pools' eastern boundary, the exceptionally photogenic Wilderness Chikwenya epitomises the national park's UNESCO World Heritage status, earned through the purity of its wilderness, beauty and wildlife sightings.
- The area is a compact concentration of scenic habitats (woodlands, floodplains, pans, islands and two iconic rivers) teeming with thrilling and diverse wildlife.
- Particularly noted for its walking safaris, Wilderness Chikwenya offers a range of other exciting adventures: on land – walking, day and night game drives; on the river – boating, catch-and-release fishing; and sensational picnics on Chikwenya Island in the river.

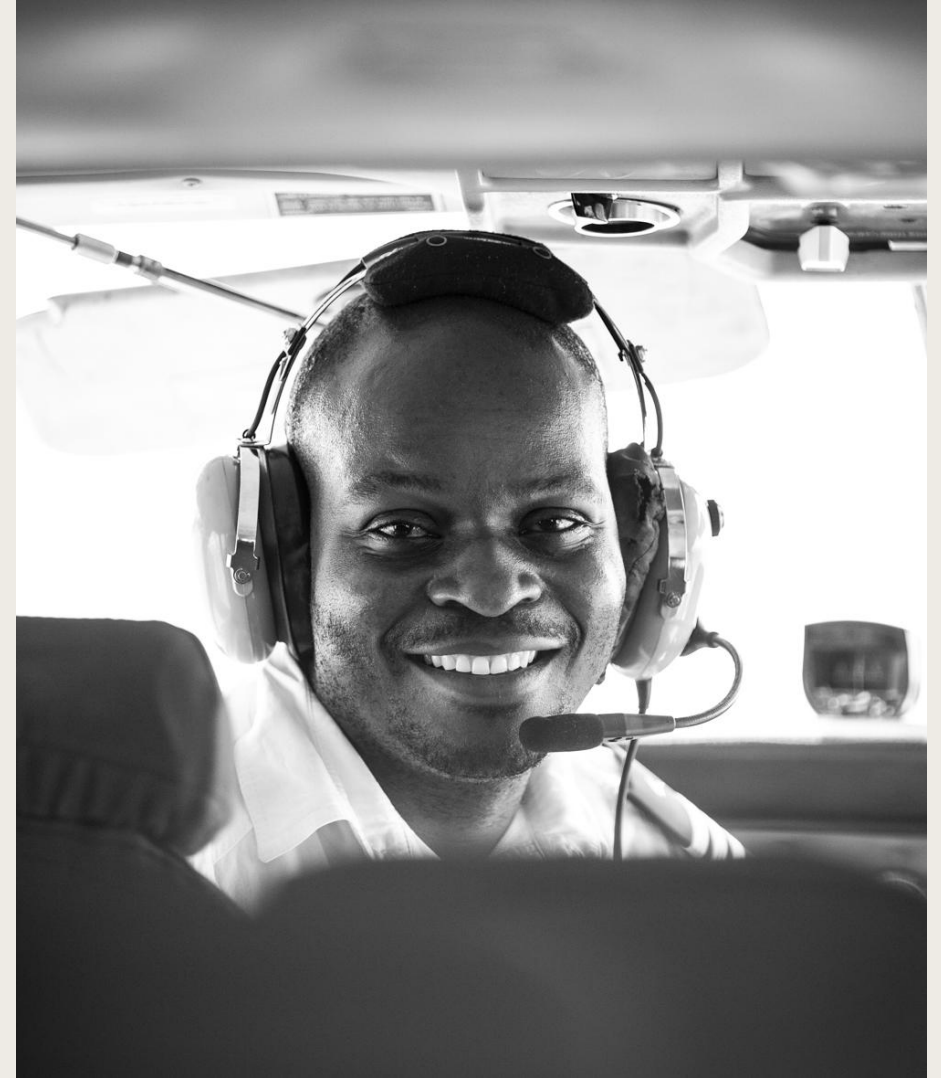

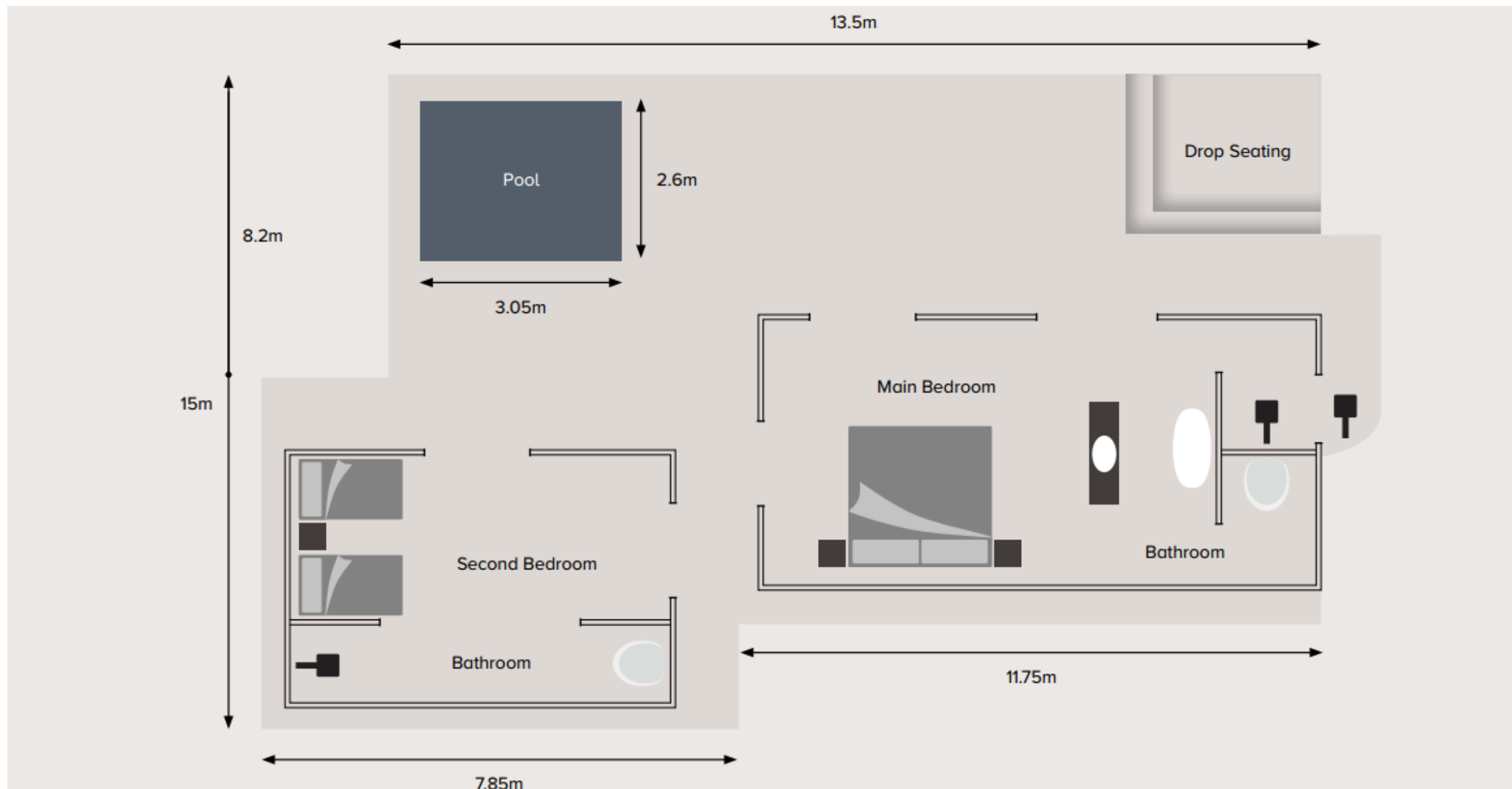
ACCOMMODATION

- With its exceptionally beautiful location on floodplains that sweep down to the broad Zambezi, and views of the dazzling Rift Valley mountains beyond, Chikwenya is noted for exceptional sightings from ‘your armchair’ in camp – not only for the ever-present elephants and diverse bird species, but many plains game seen passing through – sometimes even followed by predators.
- Tranquil and exquisite, Chikwenya’s seven elegant rooms (including two family units) are situated amongst shady albida trees – much loved by elephants, often seen feeding on tiptoe – and glorious Natal mahoganies.

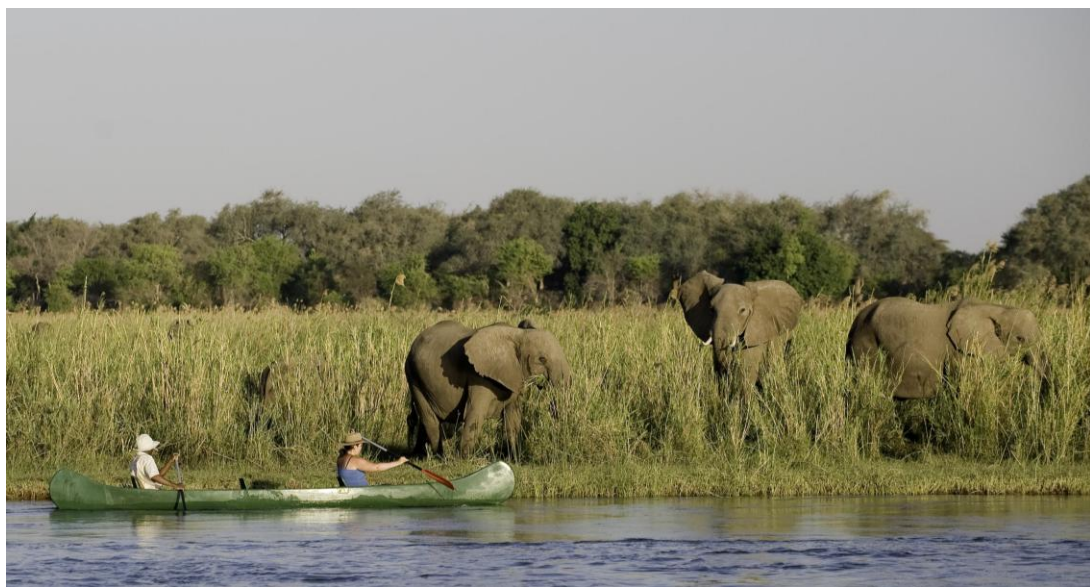
