

- Our exclusive, diverse and flexible adventures occur on the river, across the floodplains and in the woodlands, including game drives, river cruises, canoeing, catch-and-release fishing and guided nature walks.
- The concession is home to large concentrations of buffaloes and elephants, while predators such as lions, wild dogs, leopards and cheetahs are often sighted. A range of antelopes can be seen on the surrounding plains, and hippos and crocodiles crowd the river.
- Birdlife is superb. Bee-eaters nest in the riverbanks and numerous local specials, like collared palm-thrush and racket-tailed roller, are present.
