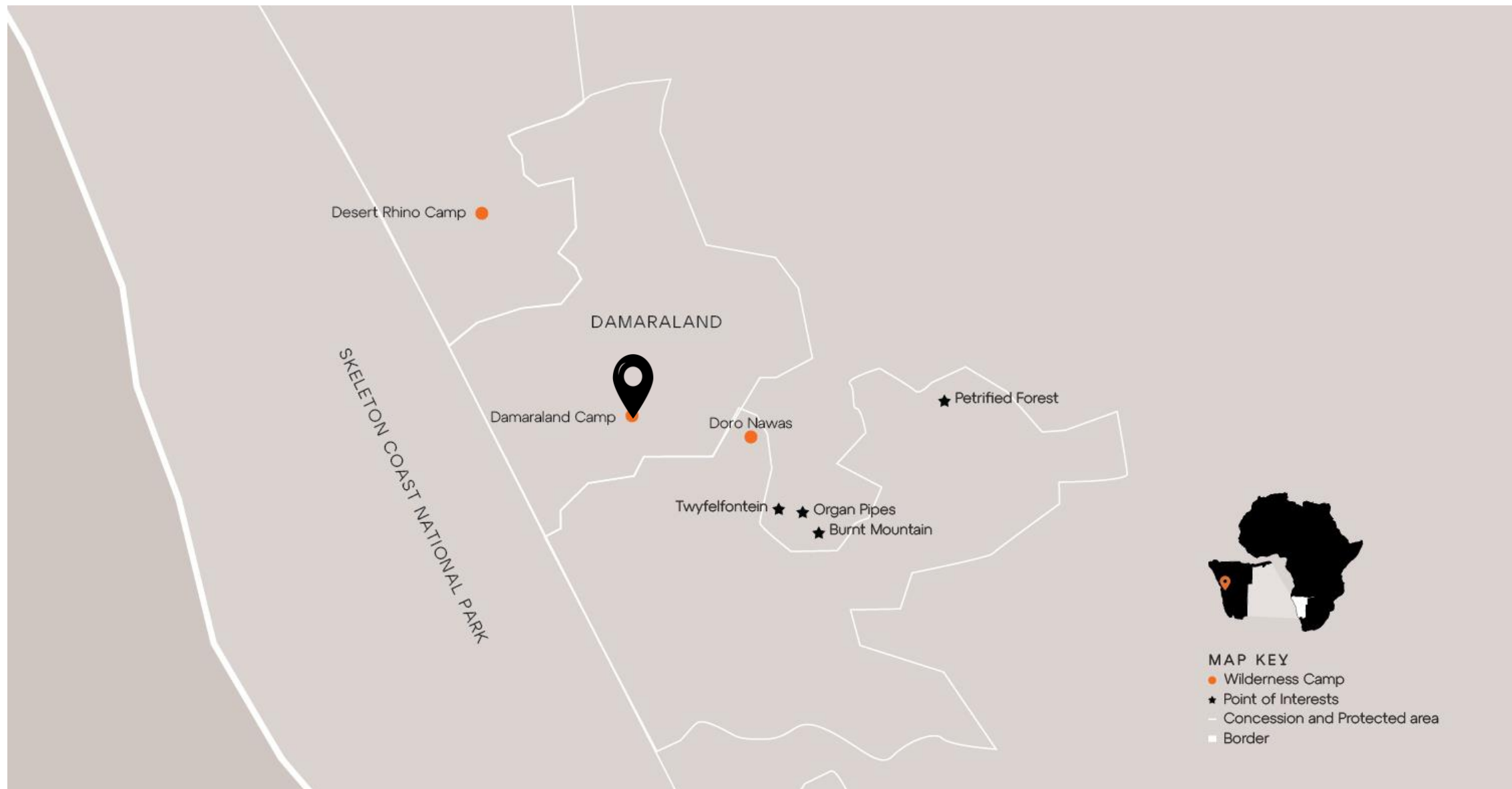

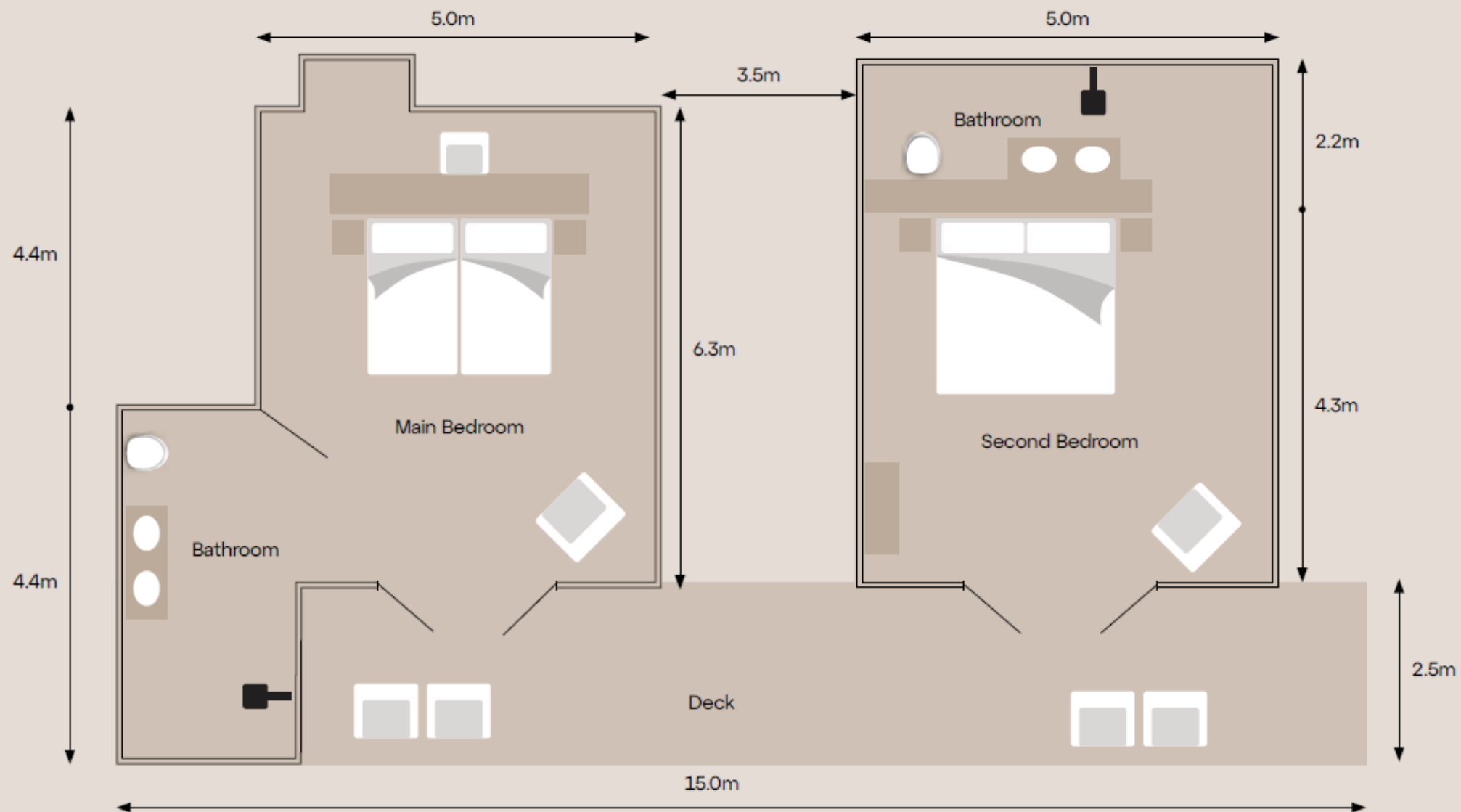
ACCOMMODATION

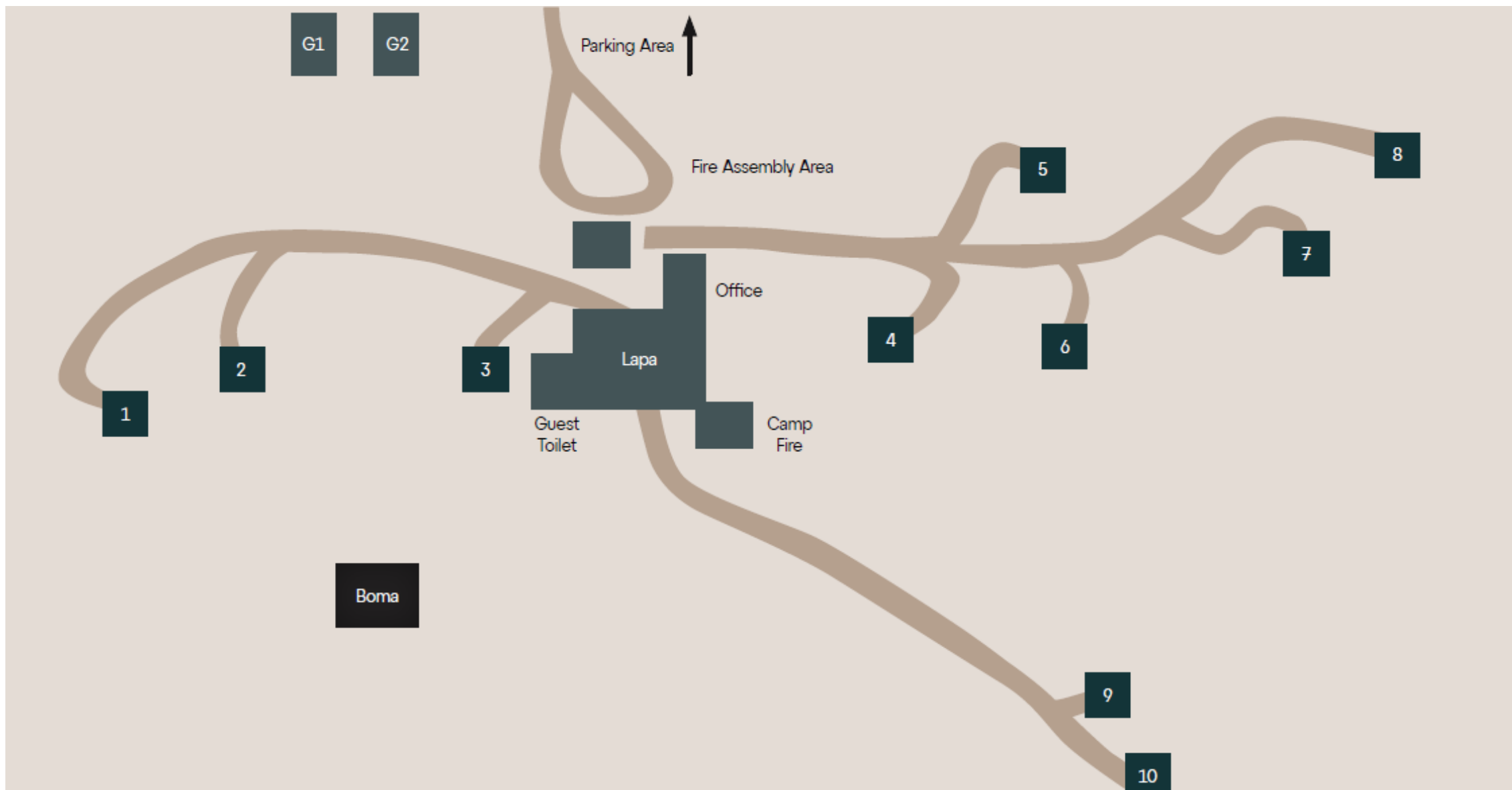
Adobe-style thatched rooms


