

- Set on 27,000 hectares of pristine private land bordering Sossusvlei, the Kulala Wilderness Reserve offers endless spectacular desert scenery and extraordinary and unexpected desert wildlife.
- Adventures exclusive to Wilderness guests within the private reserve include guided nature drives, electric fat bike excursions, hikes and nature trails by day. By night, walks reveal fascinating nocturnal activity, while the spectacular night skies offer the best in star gazing.
