CAMPS TO COMBINE WITH

Track desert-adapted black rhino at [Desert Rhino Camp](#) or explore the Skeleton Coast with a three-night stay at the [Hoanib Skeleton Coast Camp](#).

Travel further north to the Kunene River for a stay at [Serra Cafema](#), one of the few areas in Namibia where guests can experience water activities during a boating experience, explore the dunes and connect with the local Himba community.

ABOUT THE AREA

Wilderness Kulala Desert Lodge is ideally situated on 27,000 hectares of pristine private land at the foot of the majestic Sossusvlei dunes, surrounded by miles and miles of ancient desert. Its exclusive-use gate allows guests early access to explore Sossusvlei, one of the most remarkable and photogenic landscapes on Earth.

BEST TIME TO VISIT

December to March

- With good rains, a tapestry of grassland.
- Dead Vlei occasionally fills with water.
- Fewer tourists at this time of year afford a far more intimate experience
- Many of the specialist dune fauna are most active at this time of year

April to May

- Amongst the best times of the year to see the dunes
- Plains may still be covered in summer's protein-rich grasses, attracting desert-adapted wildlife

June to October

- The grasses die down, creating starkly beautiful vistas and crystal-clear red-dune silhouettes

November

- Very little grass and water with wildlife concentrating around remaining areas with water

HIGHLIGHTS

- Enjoy exclusive early access to Sossusvlei's towering red dunes and iconic Dead Vlei.
- Explore desert landscapes, geological wonders, and desert-adapted wildlife.
- Take a thrilling hot air balloon ride over the Namib Sand Sea.
- Sossusvlei's unique dunes were shaped by the Tsauchab River's flow, now blocked by sand.
