BEST TIME TO VISIT

January & February

- Excellent wildlife viewing with animals gathering near water sources. Grass is shorter, improving visibility.
- Good—many migratory birds are present.

March to May

- Start of long rainy season continuing into May.
- Lush green landscapes and dramatic skies for photography.
- Many bird species nesting and breeding.

June to September

- Start of long dry season till September.
- Prime wildlife viewing as animals move toward permanent water sources.
- Cooler temperatures, low humidity.

October & November

- Start of short rainy season.
- Rain revives vegetation. Wildlife still active. Landscapes become greener.
- Migratory birds begin to arrive.

December

- · Less rain and the short dry season.
- Good wildlife viewing.
