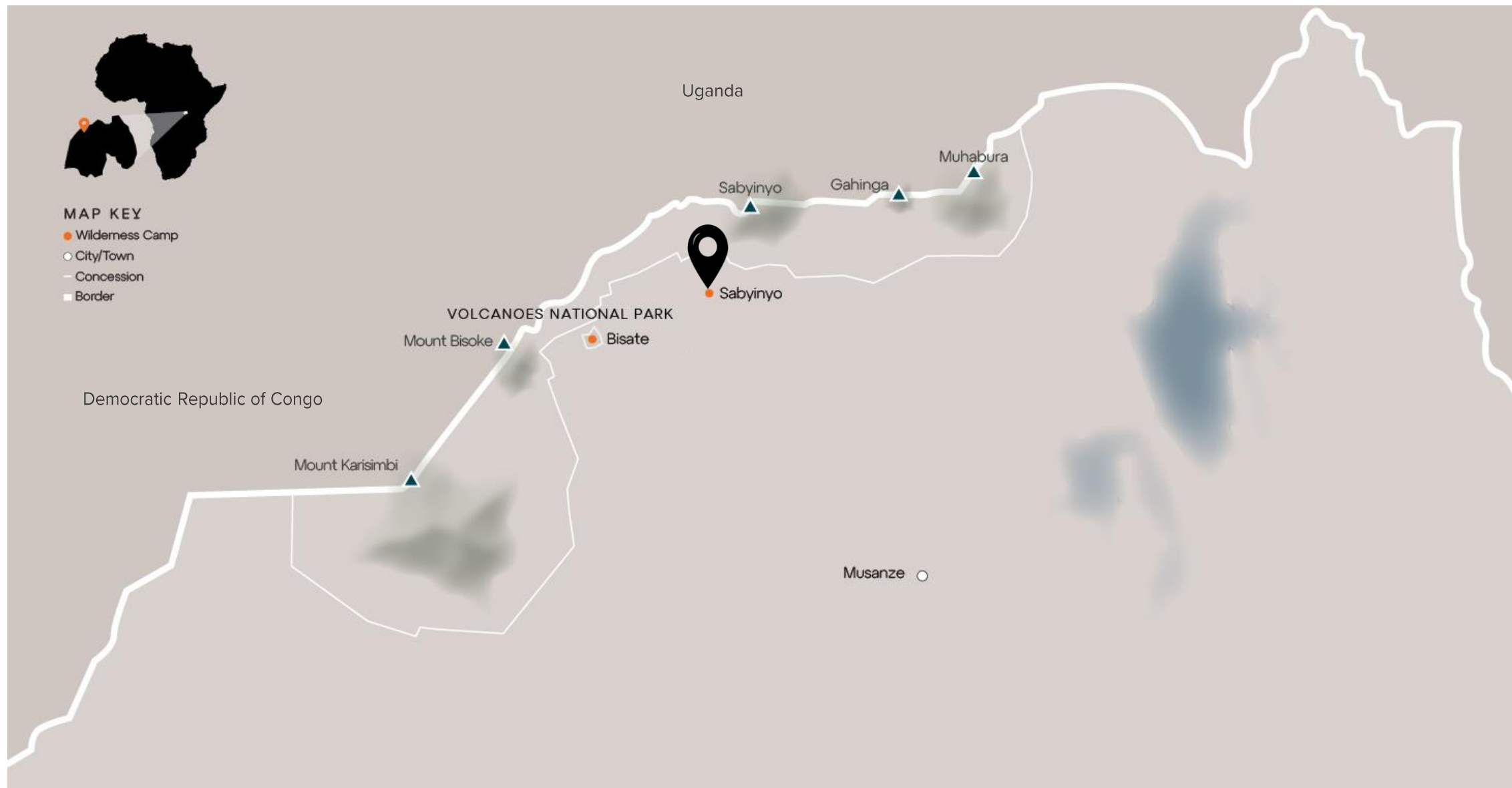

- Sabyinyo is located conveniently close to Volcanoes National Park, where guests trek habituated mountain gorillas.
- The golden monkey trek starts just five minutes from Sabyinyo. While registrations for all treks take place at Volcanoes National Park headquarters, guests' return to the lodge is quick and easy after the trek.
- With the majority of staff hailing from the local community – many of whom have spent up to 15 years working here – the camp is known for its humble, warm and authentic hospitality.

SABYINYO PURPOSE

A community for conservation

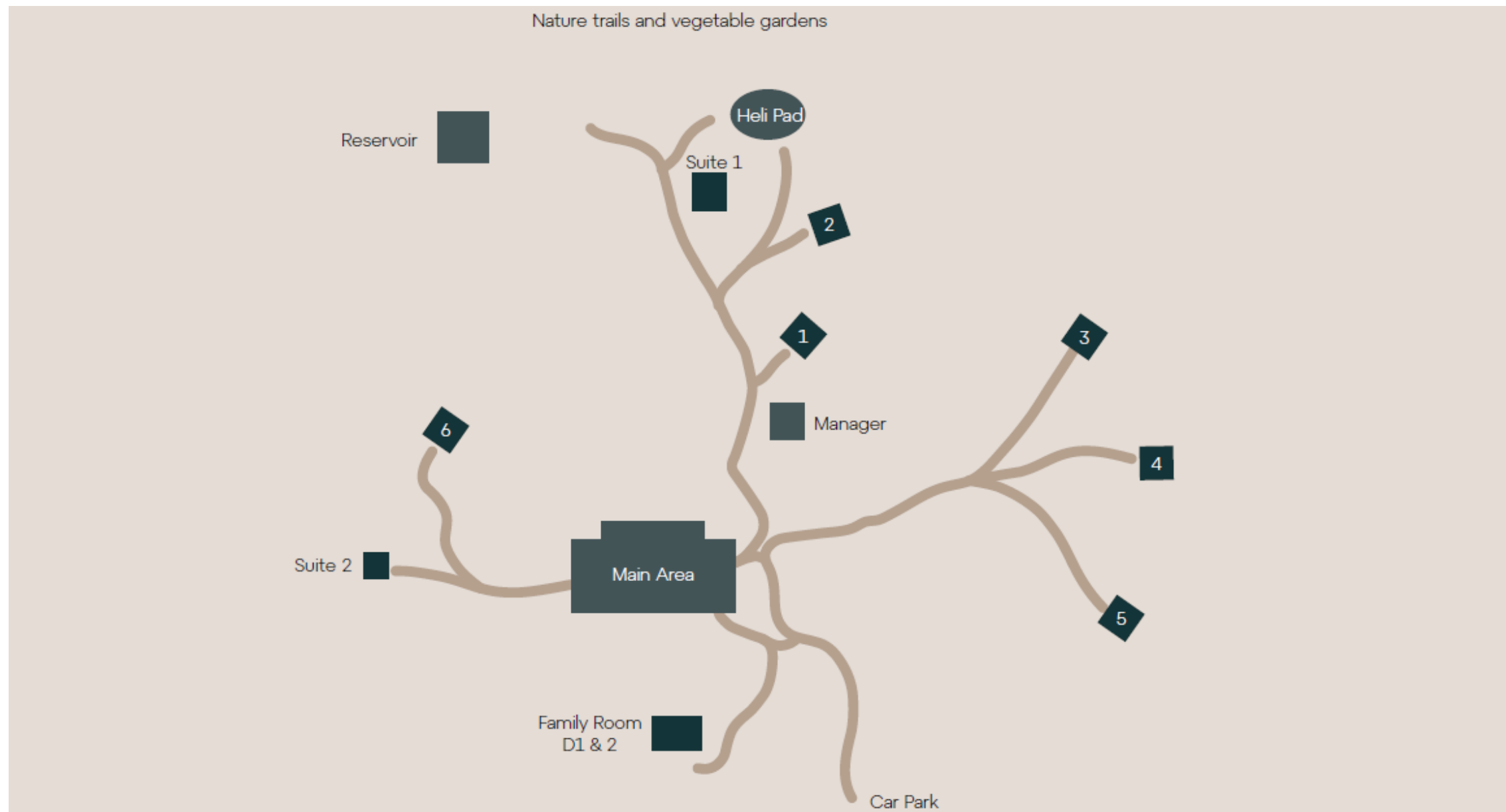
As the pioneers in mountain gorilla conservation tourism in Rwanda, Sabyinyo is Rwanda's first-ever community owned lodge. It is operated by Wilderness, but the ownership rests with the SACOLA community trust. In partnership with the African Wildlife Foundation, and the International Gorilla Conservation Program, SACOLA uses rentals and community fees from the lodge to drive socio-economic and conservation initiatives in the communities adjacent to the national park.


ACCOMMODATION

Constructed from the Earth

- Named after one of the Virunga volcanoes – also the name of a mountain gorilla group encountered in the national park – the lodge has magnificent views of Karisimbi, Bisoke, Mikenso and Sabyinyo volcanoes.
- Built from stone and volcanic rock, with Rwandan terracotta tile roofs, the cosy lodge, with fireplaces interspersed throughout, has six cottages, two suites and one family cottage
