





# ABOUT THE AREA

Mababe spans over 50,000 hectares between the Okavango Delta, Moremi, and Chobe. Fed by the Mababe River and Okavango waters, its nutrient-rich grasses support a unique mix of habitats: grasslands, woodlands, and marsh. This diverse ecosystem attracts large herds, plentiful predators, and rich birdlife. Each year, the 2,600-hectare marsh is replenished by seasonal inflow, drawing wildlife from all around.
