







ABOUT THE AREA

Wilderness DumaTau is nestled deep within the vast Linyanti Wildlife Reserve, on the northernmost fringe of Botswana. The camp takes full advantage of its unique access to 45 kilometres (28 miles) of exclusive-traversing river frontage along both the Linyanti River and the Savuti Channel and promises amazing wildlife encounters and adventures on the reserve's pristine 126,000 hectares (311,353 acres) of unfenced, untamed wilderness.




