

Toka Leya

- Situated in Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park on the banks of the Zambezi River, Toka Leya is a tranquil safari base from which to easily access and explore the Victoria Falls and the adrenaline-filled adventure hub of Livingstone.
- Listed as one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, Victoria Falls is almost 2 kilometres wide, and plunges dramatically more than 100 metres into the Batoka Gorge, raising an iridescent mist that can be seen from as far as 20 km away.
- There are many activities to enjoy from and within camp: cruises and catch-and-release fishing on the legendary Zambezi River, game drives and walks, as well as back-of-house tours showcasing our successful tree-planting and sustainability initiatives.


Wondrous views over the Zambezi


