## General Updates

- Xigera Safari Lodge will remain part of the Wilderness Safaris portfolio, although it is now wholly owned and operated by Red Carnation, who hold the inventory. Xigera Safari Lodge will continue to appear on the Wilderness Safaris website and in our brochures.
- Machaba Safaris purchased Ngoma Lodge in the Chobe area of Botswana from Africa Albida. As of 1August 2019, Ngoma Lodge will fall under the Machaba Safaris portfolio.
  - Camp Hwange and Hwange Bush Camp have advised that applicable National Parks Conservation Fees have increased with immediate effect.
- Victoria Falls River Lodge has advised that Zimbabwe Parks and Wildlife Management has increased the park fees for all new bookings, with immediate effect.
- Karkloof Safari Villas & Spa has closed with immediate effect and until further notice.
- The Mozambique Government has announced that the cost of all single-entry visas applied for in a foreign traveller's country of origin (i.e. prior to travel and arrival) have increased with immediate effect. Costs for visas obtained on entry into Mozambique remain unchanged.
