Full Day Itinerary

Collection from hotel and transfer to the Waterfront Hanger of Cape Town Helicopters. Depart on a scenic helicopter trip to the Cape of Good Hope. View the Cape Peninsula from all angles before flying along the False Bay Coast to Miller's Point – a truly unforgettable experience. Here you will be met by your guide and will join a Seaside forage experience, where you will learn how to harvest various seaweeds, and have the opportunity to taste a spread of sustainable sea-inspired delicacies. Thereafter continue in the afternoon towards the Cape of Good Hope section of the Table Mountain National Park with its unique Cape fynbos vegetation and home to birds like African black oystercatchers and Cape sugarbirds as well as to very special fauna including Cape mountain zebra, bontebok (both endemic) and the charismatic Cape baboon. Climb (or ride the world's first environmentally friendly funicular) to the famous Cape Point Lighthouse to capture the magical vistas of False Bay. On the way back visit Boulders Beach to see the penguins, and then head home through the naval village of Simonstown and over scenic Boyes Drive, taking in the views of the fishing harbour at Kalk Bay and the seaside havens of St. James and Muizenberg.
