General Updates:

<u>Electronics Ban on Certain Airlines</u> - The United States (US) and United Kingdom (UK) have issued a ban on certain electronic devices, including cameras, on flights from certain hubs in the Middle East. The ban prohibits most electronic devices, including laptops, cameras, gaming devices and tablets, from being allowed in the cabin of the flight. The nine airlines that operate direct flights to the US from affected airports are Egypt Air, Emirates Airline, Etihad Airways, Kuwait Airways, Qatar Airways, Royal Air Maroc, Royal Jordanian Airlines, Saudi Arabian Airlines and Turkish Airlines. Only a smart phone is allowed in the cabin on flights to and from these hubs on the US leg. The UK restrictions apply to 14 airlines – British Airways, EasyJet, Jet2.com, Monarch, Thomas Cook, Thomson, Turkish Airlines, Pegasus Airways, Atlas-Global Airlines, Middle East Airlines, Egypt Air, Royal Jordanian, Tunis Air and Saudia. Medical devices are excluded.
