## *General Updates:*

### **Andersson's Camp – Revised opening date**

An update to my previous communication: We have further boosted the Anderson's at Ongava project with multiple improvements. As a result the previously intended opening date (July, 2018) is no longer attainable. Plus we have chosen not to begin building while the current property is in operation. The new opening date is set for 15th of March 2019 and will be integrated with the new Ongava Research Centre campus.

We are in the final stages of an immense renovations project at our renowned **Sossusvlei Lodge** anticipated to be completed at end of June 2017. This exciting revamp encompasses an elegant new look for all guest rooms, the lobby, restaurant, pool and bar area.

**Sossusvlei Lodge** now offers a combination of 44 superior and 3 standard family units as well as a luxurious Junior Suite which has been carefully planned to blend in perfectly with the surrounding natural environment and to retain the authentic feeling of being close to nature.

The **Superior Units** feature a patio to enjoy the magnificent views over the Desert landscapes and a spacious air-conditioned bedroom featuring twin beds. In addition there is a corner couch, refreshment area with tea and coffee making facilities, fridge, luggage space, in-room safe and a complimentary turn-down service. Each of the stylish en suite bathrooms is equipped with a modern corner bathtub, spacious shower, toilet and double vanity.

The **Standard Family Units** feature two rooms back to back connected by a lockable inter-leading door between the two private bathrooms. The interiors and décor are the same as the superior units and the en suite bathroom features a double vanity, toilet and spacious shower.

The elegant **Junior Suite** serves as a tranquil romantic retreat in the Desert. Designed to fully take advantage of the unsurpassed views extending over the Desert landscapes, the Suite consists of a spacious air-conditioned bedroom with a luxurious queen-size bed, an adjacent living area and a private terrace boasting a small splash pool. In addition there is an elegant bathroom with walk-in shower, separate toilet, double vanity and a freestanding feature bath underneath a skylight to admire the star studded skies whilst taking a relaxing bath. Amenities include a refreshment area with tea and coffee making facilities, fridge, spacious closet, comfortable couch, safe and a complimentary turn-down service.

### **Zambezi Mubala Lodge now open:**

Along the edge of the mighty Zambezi River, lies the water sanctuary of Zambezi Mubala Lodge. A bird-lover's dream, this lodge is home to one of the largest colonies of Carmine Bee-eaters, which live along the banks of the majestic Zambezi. Birds are often joined by the occasional hippo or crocodile, basking in the shallow waters along the banks. Guests can relax and watch the colours of life sail along the steady current of the river.

The Zambezi Mubala Lodge is located 40km east of Katima Mulilo on the Namibian riverbank of the Zambezi, overlooking Zambia – in the heart of untouched nature. Day trips to the famous Victoria Falls, the Chobe National Park and other national parks in the region are not to be missed.
