KAZA UniVisa relaunched on 21st December 2016.

- Costs US\$ 50.00, valid for up to 30 days as long as visitors remain within Zambia & Zimbabwe and also applies to those who visit Botswana on day trips.
- Available on arrival at Harry Mwaanga Nkumbula International Airport (Livingstone), Victoria Falls land border, Kazangula land border, Kenneth Kaunda International Airport (Lusaka), Victoria Falls International Airport, and Harare International Airport.
