After spending some time with the Anti-poaching Units in North Luangwa National Park helping protect the Park's elephant population he honed his talents as a lodge/camp manager and then later as a guide/ranger and spent his first years guiding in Zimbabwe and Malawi. His passion has taken him on numerous adventures to some amazing places. His speciality is Botswana, but once guests have travelled with Dave, they don't want to travel with anyone else again. He has subsequently led trips to Namibia, Rwanda, South Africa, Tanzania, Uganda, Zambia and Zimbabwe. He has also led expeditions to photograph polar bears in the Arctic, and recently (November 2011) explored and photographed The Falkland Islands (Islas Malvinas), South Georgia and the Antarctic. West Papua (Indonesia) including Raja Ampat was his latest visit, exploring the rich fish diversity of the exquisite coral reefs and trekking to find the rare Red Bird of Paradise on Gam Island.

He is an exceptional all-round guide, but has special interests in:

- Photography
- Ornithology
- Mammals Predators and elephants in particular
- Family-orientated safaris
- Walking and canoe trails
