Day 1, 2 & 3 On arrival at Kigali International Airport, you will be met by an Akagera Aviation representative and assisted with Customs & Immigration clearance. Depart on a private road transfer with Thousand Hills Africa to Bisate Lodge (approximately three hours' drive) for a three-night stay.

Day 4 Private road transfer from Bisate to Kigali Serena Hotel. Enjoy a privately-guided tour of Kigali.

Our recommendation: Upgrade your access to/ from Bisate Lodge with an exciting one-way or return helicopter transfer utilising the Musanza airstrip – a 10-minute drive from Bisate Lodge. Day 5, 6 & 7 Depart Rwanda on commercial scheduled flight to Kenya (costs not included). On arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, you will be met by a SwissPort representative who will assist with Customs & Immigration clearance. Private charter transfer from Nairobi to Angama Mara for a three-night stay.

Day 8, 9 & 10 Private charter flight from Angama Mara to Segera Retreat for a three-night stay.

Day 11 Private charter flight from Segera Retreat to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for onward travel arrangements.


Note

Depending on the scheduled commercial flights booked between Rwanda and Kenya, an overnight in Nairobi may replace the overnight in Kigali.

In this instance, you will be met at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport and transferred by Angama Mara to Hemingways Hotel for your overnight stay.

The following morning, you will be collected and transferred to Wilson Airport for your private charter flight to Angama Mara.

Bisate Lodge

Bisate Lodge has dramatic views of the Bisoke and Karisimbi volcanic peaks rising through the forests of nearby Volcanoes National Park. It is within easy driving distance of Park Headquarters, from where once-in-a-lifetime gorilla treks depart daily. Exploring around Bisate includes community visits, birding, golden monkey tracking, tree-planting to help reforest the area, the Gorilla Guardian Village, the Twin Lakes of Ruhondo and Burera, and Dian Fossey's grave. Six opulent en-suite forest villas are each warmed by a central fireplace and have breathtaking views from their decks. The main area comprises a lounge, dining and bar area, wine cellar and viewing deck. Both the architecture and interior design are rooted in Rwandan cultural traditions. The aim of Bisate is to be a model of sustainable ecotourism in Rwanda. Its reforestation and rehabilitation project has each quest partnering with us in contributing to conservation and local community upliftment, with a positive impact on the iconic Critically Endangered mountain gorilla.

Angama Mara


With a seat on the edge of Africa's Great Rift Valley, Angama Mara has views that stretch for miles across the Maasai Mara National Reserve below. Two separate camps comprise of just 15 luxurious tents fitted with glass frontage and wooden decks. Dining, relaxing and socialising take place in the magnificent guest area which includes a handsome brick-clad library. The Pavilion, set between the two camps, is home to the Safari Shop, a swimming pool and a fitness room.

Activities include tailor-made game drives, walking safaris, a picnic on the crest of the "Out of Africa" kopje, lunches in Angama Mara's one-acre vegetable garden and opportunities to interact with the Maasai people. Hot air balloon safaris can be arranged at an additional cost. Built on the site where many lovely scenes from Out of Africa were filmed, Angama Mara is filled with subtle touchpoints that celebrate the much-loved novel and film.

Segera Retreat

Six sumptuous timber and thatch villas rise out of a profusion of botanical life, each offering a private sun deck with sun loungers, a swing bed and a Jacuzzi bath. The convivial and opulent main areas are filled with contemporary African art from the Zeitz Collection. Diverse game-viewing and natural beauty is complemented by a culture of wellness that extends to the soil, the environment and the communities that surround Segera.

A tour of Segera's fascinating back-of-house facilities offers a true understanding of the 4Cs sustainability concept. From the farm-to-table kitchens and vegetable gardens to the solar farm, water and waste recycling systems, wildlife protection units and beyond, it is a fascinating experience for those interested to learn about the management of such a large conservation operation.
