Greetings from Africa!

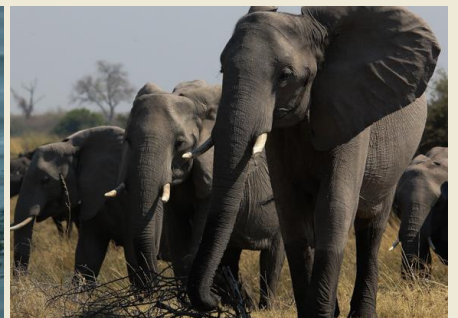
As we slowly approach the end of the year we reflect on some of the life-changing journeys we have shared with our guests. Here are some of their memories...
