ZIMBABWE

On Friday 09 June 2023, Zimbabwe dropped its COVID-19-related entry health regulations with immediate effect. The Minister of Health issued an order that returning residents and visitors to Zimbabwe no longer need to produce a negative PCR COVID test, or a vaccination certificate at the port of entry.

Airlines

Air France has launched a new route to Dar es Salaam.

- The Dar es Salaam flight, which will be an extension of the Zanzibar service, will operate three times a week.
- Flight AF876 departs from Paris-Charles de Gaulle at 10h20 on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays, arriving in Zanzibar at 20h15.
- The flight departs Zanzibar at 22h45 and arrives in Dar es Salaam at 22h20.
- The return flight departs Dar es Salaam at 23h50 on the same days, and arrives at Paris-Charles de Gaulle at 07h55 the following day.
- Additional services
- Air France has also increased its flights to Nairobi, which will now be served daily with direct flights in both directions. There are currently six flights per week.
- The airline has also increased flight frequencies to Antananarivo, Madagascar, offering five non-stop weekly flights, instead of the current four.

Airlink will increase its return flights between Johannesburg and Vilanculos, Mozambique to 11 a week from 08 January 2024.

- The airline currently operates a daily service on the route. The decision to add another flight every Monday, Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday is in response to increased demand.
- The schedule change will, however, see the cancellation of direct flights between Mbombela (formerly Nelspruit) and Vilanculos after 05 January 2024.
- Guests who would have travelled directly from Mbombela to Vilanculos will still be able to combine their bush safaris and exotic beach experiences using Airlink connections through Johannesburg-OR Tambo International.
