Botswana's Okavango Delta lies in the heart of the arid Kalahari, and is a phenomenal wilderness to behold; in the country's north-east, the Linganti Wildlife Reserve, set alongside Chobe National Park, is renowned for its predators and large concentrations of game.

Experience these two fascinating areas in our private and scenic concessions, while luxuriating in the delights of two of our newest camps: King's Pool and Jao.

The grand finale takes place in Victoria Falls, where – after exploring the spectacular World Heritage Site – we connect with friends and other safari specialists, to gain first-hand knowledge from experts, exchange ideas and inspire each other in a two-day conservation workshop.

INCLUSIONS:

- Meals as specified
- Flights between Maun Airport – King's Pool – Jao – Kasane Airport.
- Road transfer between Kasane Airport - Toka Leya – Stanley and Livingstone – Victoria Falls Airport.
- **King's Pool and Jao camps:** all meals, twice daily scheduled camp activities, park fees, laundry and all local drinks excludes premium imported brands and champagne

- **Toka Leya:** all meals, twice daily scheduled camp activities, park fees, laundry, a guided tour of the Zambian side of The Victoria Falls, a guided tour of Livingstone town and Livingstone Museum, sunset river cruise, visit to a local African village and all local drinks excludes premium imported brands and champagne
- **Stanley and Livingstone Boutique Hotel:** breakfast, scheduled shared Victoria Falls Airport transfers and scheduled shared Victoria Falls town transfers - 3 transfers per day, VAT, government levies and Emergency medical evacuation.

- Air transfers as specified, including Departure Taxes as relevant on Wilderness Air in Botswana and Namibia;
- Accommodation taxes, the applicable Tourism Levies and all relevant Value Added Tax (VAT) or Government Sales Tax (GST).

- Meals not specified in the quote such as lunch and dinner at Stanley and Livingstone Boutique hotels


- Any drinks, park fees, entrance fees, portorage, tours/ excursions and transfers not specified in the inclusions

DAY 1 & 2 KING'S POOL, LINYANTI WILDERNESS RESERVE

Named for Scandinavian royalty, King's Pool is located at the crux of the important wildlife corridor that straddles Angola, Namibia, Zambia and Botswana – meaning it is the centre of vital conservation initiatives. Looking out over a sparkling oxbow lagoon, spacious rooms and expansive decks echo the natural spaces of this unique wilderness. Activities include game drives, guided walks, barge cruises and two scenically located hides, ideal to visit at siesta time.

DAY 3 & 4 **JAO, OKAVANGO DELTA**

DAY 5 TOKA LEYA

A safari-style sanctuary situated on the banks of the Zambezi River, Toka Leya provides a peaceful wilderness experience just 12 km upstream from the Victoria Falls. With luxurious outdoor baths, a wellness centre complete with yoga/meditation deck and a private veranda overlooking the rushing, roaring river, there is ample space to relax, participate in the camp's tree rehabilitation initiative – or set off on one of the many adventurous activities we have on offer, including visiting the Falls, Livingstone town, Livingstone Museum and a local African village, as well as a gorgeous sunset river cruise.
